




Data in this Communication present previous results and they can undergo certain modifications.

industrial production of small-scale and middle-scale enterprizes would be included, index of industrial production for March
2004/ average for total industrial production would be 102,2 and for manufacturing 106,7.

**Comment:** Industrial production in Republic of Serbia (data for Kosovo and Metohia not included) in April 2004 increased for 2,9% in relation to average 2003 and increased for 4,0% in relation to April 2003. Industrial production in the period January-April 2004 in relation to the same period last year increased for 8,0%. Observed by sectors, in April 2004 in relation to average 2003 the increase was realized in sector of Manufacturing for 8,6%, whilst Electricity, gas and water supply notices decrease of 18,5% and Mining and quarrying notices decrease of 0,3%. Data of Industrial production by aimed groups in April 2004 in relation to average 2003 show increase in Capital goods industries for 22,7%, Intermediate goods industries (except energy) for 20,2%, but decrease in Manufacture of Energy for 11,3%, Non-durable consumer goods industries 3,0% and Durable consumer goods industries 2,6%.

Positive trend of total Industrial production and Manufacturing in relation to average last year production is continued in April. Industrial production in April 2004 in relation to average 2003 notices increase in 18 fields that in industrial production structure participate with 45% of production, and decrease in 11 fields that in industrial production structure participate with 55% of production.

However, production in April 2004 in relation to March 2004 notices decrease in 14 fields that in industrial production participate with 65,1% of production. The biggest decrease of production is seasonal and it was realized in manufacture of energy and production of coal.

The negative trend in production of manufacture of confectiory, beverages, plastic products, standard metal products, machinery and equipment except electrical and tobacco products, influenced on the decrease of the production.

The production of small-scale and middle-scale enterprises which were not included by regularly statistical researching is conducted on the sample of 300 chosen units. In March 130 enterprises distributed demanded data. When evaluation of industrial production of small-scale and middle-scale enterprises from sample is included, industrial production in April in relation to average 2003 has increased for 2,2% in total industrial production and for 6,7% in manufacturing industry.

From January 2004 in observing monthly industrial production several changes were involved: new nomenclature of industrial products (reconciled with EU), new weight system and increased implication of economic subjects.

The data of industrial production by months 2004 and total industrial production in 2003 were collected by new standards. As a result of data collected, indices are calculated which show trend of industrial production in 2004 in relation to the same month last year, it was started on supposition that the tendency of industrial production changes by the months 2003 is the same according to the new and the old standards industry as a whole and sectors.

Data of industrial production in 2004 will be published at the end of the month for previous one.
