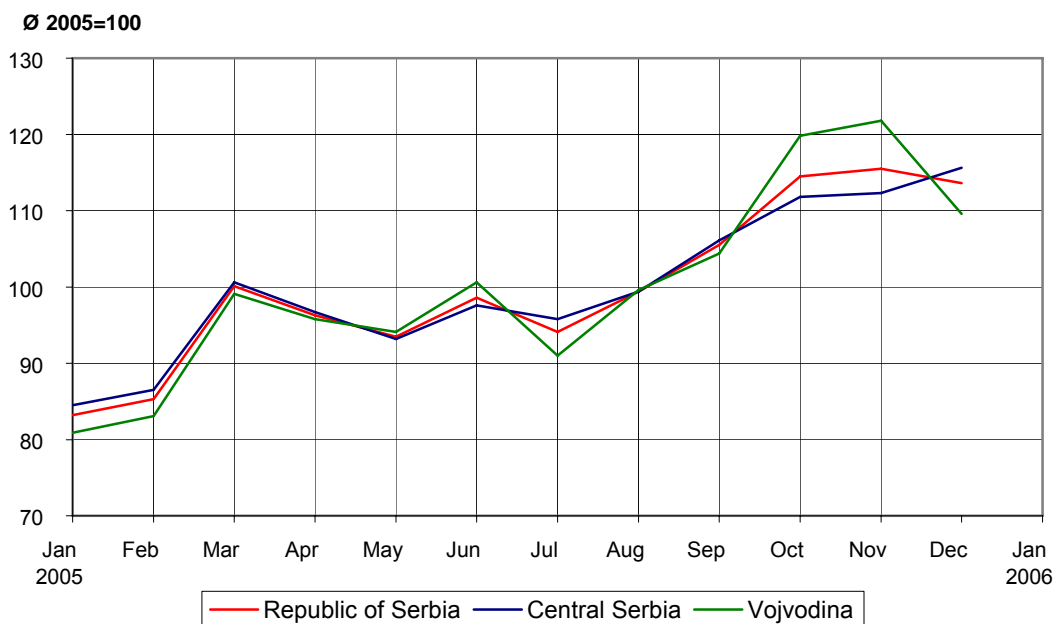

The estimate was made on the basis of the sample. If the estimate of industrial production of small-sized enterprises is included, the industrial production index for Januar 2006/2005 average, for total industrial production stands at 85,5 and for manufacturing 76,6.

Industrial production in the Republic of Serbia, in January 2006 was by 16,1% lower compared to 2005 average and was by 0,8% greater compared to January 2005.

Observed by sectors, January 2006, compared to 2005 average, in the mining and quarrying sector saw a 4,4% fall, while the production in the manufacturing sector saw a 25,6% fall, while the production in the sector for electricity, gas and water supply increased by 18,8%.
