The number of **passenger cars** registered in the Republic of Serbia in 2005 is by 1.8% increased in relation to the number of registered cars in the previous year. The number of registered **buses** in the Republic of Serbia is increased by 5.3%, in the central Serbia it is increased by 6.2%, while in Vojvodina it is increased by 2.4%. The most dynamic growth, equal to 10.9%, noted the category of **working vehicles**.

The number of 587245 passenger cars of domestic production, **ZASTAVA** brand, was registered. Regarding the passenger cars of foreign production, in 2005 the number of 162859 cars of various **OPEL** models was registered, then 162018 **VOLSWAGEN** cars, 71678 **FORD** cars, 49211 **MERCEDES** cars, 47942 **RENAULT** cars and 47752 **FIAT** cars were registered. Also registered were 36082 **SKODA** passenger cars, 33754 **PEUGEOT** cars, 16388 **TOYOTA** cars, 15835 **BMW** cars, 13945 **MAZDA** cars, 9084 **MITSUBISHI** cars, 7609 **DAEWOO** cars, 5648 **HYUANDAI** cars, 4650 **HONDA** cars and 2517 **KIA** cars.

The number of first time registered passenger cars in the Republic of Serbia in 2005 was by 35.3% lower when compared to the previous year. The number of first time registered buses was by 86.3% higher and the number of tracking vehicles was by 51.1% higher.

In the Republic of Serbia we had first time registered 10476 passenger cars of **ZASTAVA** models, 3111 passenger cars of **VOLKSWAGEN** models, then 3105 **OPEL** passenger cars, 2611 **SKODA** passenger cars, 2536 **FIAT** passenger cars, 1932 **RENAULT** passenger cars, 1841 **PEUGEOT** passenger cars, 1280 **FORD** passenger cars, 1004 **TOYOTA** passenger cars, 900 **MERCEDES** passenger cars and 755 **HYUNDAI** passenger cars.

The total number of traffic accidents in 2005 is by 4.6% decreased in relation to the previous year. Traffic accidents with killed people are more rapidly decreasing if compared to the traffic accidents with injured.

The number of casualties in 2005 is by 4.3% decreased relative to 2004. The number of killed people in traffic accidents is by 11.8% lower and the number of injured is by 3.9% lower.
