Total number of passenger's motor vehicles that entered Serbia in first and second quarter of 2009 increased by 19%, compared to the same period of the previous year. Number of vehicles registered in our country decreased by 3.5%, while number of vehicles registered abroad increased by 35.4%. Among foreign vehicles, the greatest number was registered in Bosnia and Herzegovina, 15.6%, then in Croatia, 6.6% and Bulgaria, 5.3%.

Exit of passengers motor vehicles from Serbia increased by 1.7%, compared with the same period 2008. Exit of vehicles with registration of Serbia and Montenegro increased by 2.6%, while in the same period, exit of vehicles with foreign registration increased by 1.1%. The most numerous were vehicles with registration of Bosnia and Herzegovina (18.5%), followed by vehicles registered in Croatia (7.9%) and Bulgaria (6.3%).

The greatest number of vehicles entered over the border crossings with Bosnia and Herzegovina (34.5%) and Croatia (25.4%). The greatest number of vehicles entered Serbia over the Batrovci boarder crossing (18.4%), followed by Horgos (12.2%) and Presevo (7.2%).

The greatest number of passengers transport vehicles exited over the border crossings with Bosnia and Herzegovina (31.8%) and Croatia (26.2%). Three border crossings with the greatest traffic of passengers vehicles in exit from Serbia are: Batrovci (18.5%), Horgos (11.1%) and Presevo (6.3%).

Total number of passengers that entered Serbia by all modes of transport in the first and second quarter of 2009 decreased by 1.8% in comparison with the same period 2008. Number of passengers in vehicles with registration of Serbia and Montenegro decreased by 2.7% and in vehicles with foreign registration by 1.1%. Total number of passengers that exited from Serbia in the first and second quarter of 2009 increased by 0.9%, compared to the same period 2008. Number of passengers in vehicles with domestic registration increased by 3.7%, while number of passengers in vehicles with foreign registration decreased by 1.2%.

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
