The total number of passenger motor vehicles that entered Serbia in first, second and third quarter 2009 increased by 16%, compared to the same period of the previous year. The number of vehicles registered in our country decreased by 1.6%, while the number of vehicles registered abroad increased by 24.5%. Among foreign vehicles, the largest number was registered in Bosnia and Herzegovina, 12.7%, then in Germany, 7.1%, and in Croatia, 5.1%.

The exit of passenger motor vehicles from Serbia increased by 1.9%, compared with the same period 2008. The exit of vehicles registered in Serbia and Montenegro increased by 0.2%, while in the same period, the exit of vehicles with foreign registration plates increased by 3%. The largest number of vehicles was registered in Bosnia and Herzegovina, 15.1%, then come those registered in Germany, 7.5 % and in Croatia, 6.1% of the overall exit.

The largest number of vehicles entered through the border crossings with Bosnia and Herzegovina, 27.9%, and with Croatia, 24.9%. The largest number of vehicles entered Serbia through the Batrovci border crossing, 18.9%, followed by Horgos, 13%, and Presevo, 9%.

The largest number of passengers transport vehicles exited through the border crossings with Bosnia and Herzegovina, 27.6%, and then with Croatia, 24.5%. Three border crossings with the most frequent traffic of passenger transport vehicles in exit from Serbia were: Batrovci, 18.1%, Horgos, 11.6% and Presevo, 8.2%.

The total number of passengers that entered Serbia by all modes of transport in the first, second and third quarter 2009 decreased by 0.6% in comparison with the same period 2008. The number of passengers in vehicles registered in Serbia and Montenegro increased by 0.7% and in vehicles with foreign registration plates it decreased by 1.5%. The total number of passengers that exited from Serbia in the first, second and third quarter 2009 increased by 1.5% compared to the same period 2008. The number of passengers in domestic vehicles increased by 3.4%, while the number of passengers in vehicles with foreign registration plates increased by 0.3%.
