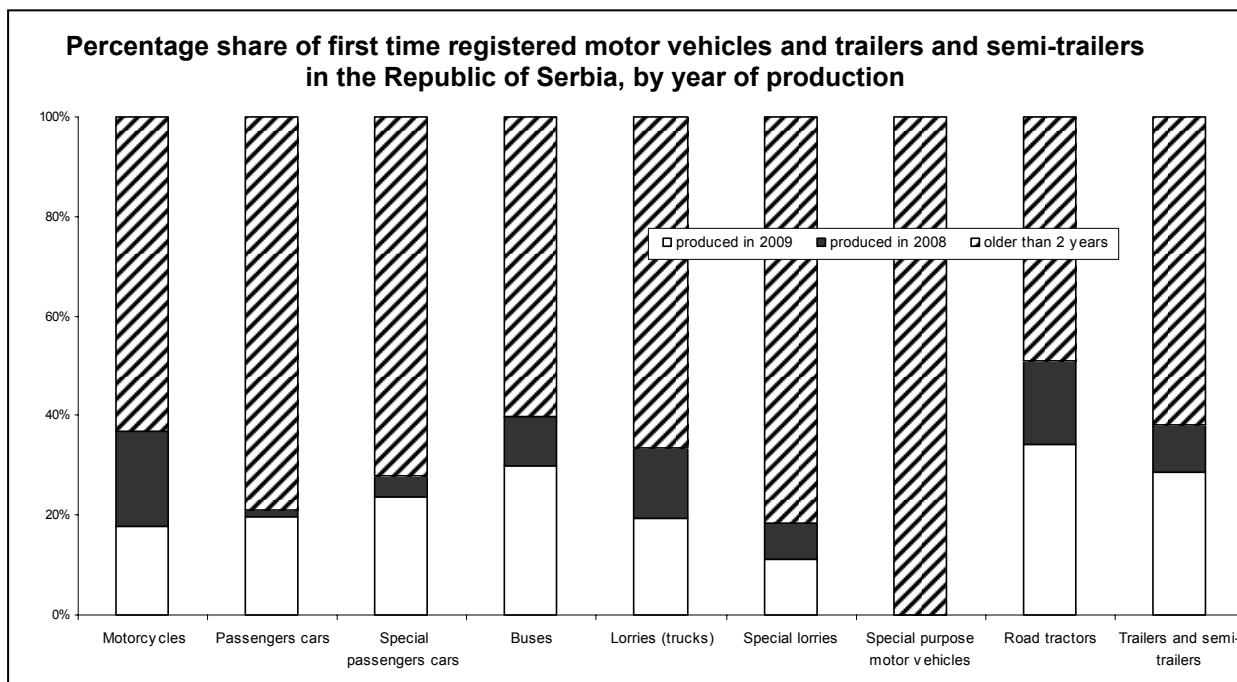

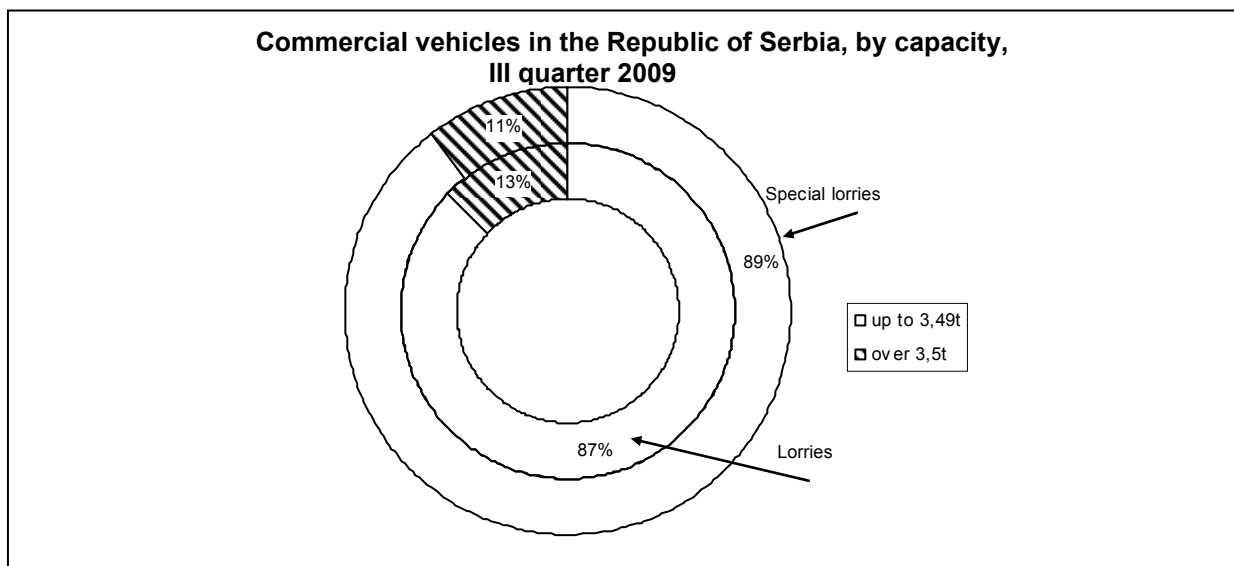

Number of first time registered passengers cars in the third quarter of 2009 in the Republic of Serbia is almost two times greater when compared to the same period 2008. Such significant increase of the number of first time registered passengers cars is, first of all, the result of pre-registration of passengers cars with Montenegrin registration to registration of the Republic of Serbia. 79.2% of first time registered passengers cars in III quarter 2009 are cars older than three years, by year of production. Number of motorcycles, first time registered in III quarter 2009 in the Republic of Serbia decreased by 44.4%, compared to the same period 2008. The greatest number of motor vehicles was produced by the following manufacturers: *Zastava* (domestic trademark) and *VW, Fiat, Opel and Renault* (foreign trademarks).



Decrease of registered commercial vehicles is noted in all categories of vehicles, relative to 2008.



Total number of injury road accidents in the third quarter of 2009 was increased by 3.1%, when compared to the same period 2008.

Number of casualties in the third quarter of 2009 was increased by 5.8% respective to the same period 2008, while number of killed persons increased by 1.9%.
