Number of passengers cars registered in 2009 in the Republic of Serbia increased by 10.1% in comparison with the previous year, while number of lorries (trucks) increased by 6.5%. The greatest increase was noted in the category of motorcycles (8.5%).

The greatest number of registered passengers' cars was produced by Zastava (domestic trademark). Regarding foreign trademarks, the following manufacturers were the most notable: Volkswagen, Opel, Ford, Fiat, Renault, Mercedes, Peugeot and Skoda.

Number of first time registered passengers' cars in 2009 in the Republic of Serbia increased by 44.8%, relative to the previous year and number of special passengers' cars increased by 82.9%. Such particular increase resulted from compulsory pre-registration of vehicles with Montenegrin registration to Serbian registration.

Total number of injury road accidents in 2009 decreased by 5.1% when compared to 2008. The greatest number of accidents was noted within built-up areas and amounted to 86.0% of total number of accidents.

Number of casualties in 2009 compared to 2008, decreased by 3.7%, while number of killed persons decreased by almost 10.0%.
