



Number of buses registered for the first time in the fourth quarter of 2009 in the Republic of Serbia increased by 22.4% and number of passengers cars increased by 39.3%, when compared to the same period 2008. The greatest number of motor vehicles was produced by the following manufacturers: Zastava (domestic trademark) and Fiat, Renault, Opel, and VW (foreign trademarks).



The greatest increase of number of registered commercial vehicles is noted in the category of special lorries, amounting to 3.9%, while other commercial vehicles recorded decrease by around 25,5%.

In the category of lorries and special lorries, the most frequent are those with capacity of up to 3.5t.



Total number of injury road accidents in the fourth quarter of 2009 was decreased by 13.1%, when compared to the same period 2008. The greatest decrease of injury accidents with killed persons, by 33.1%, was recorded outside built-up areas.

Number of casualties in the fourth quarter of 2009 was decreased by 12.0% respective to the same period 2008, while number of killed persons decreased by 22.8%.
