The total number of passenger motor vehicles that entered Serbia in 2009 increased by 13.4%, compared to the same period of the previous year. The number of vehicles registered in our country increased by 1.6% and the number of vehicles registered abroad by 20.5%. Among foreign vehicles, the largest number was registered in Bosnia and Herzegovina, 15.7%, then in Croatia, 7.2 and in Germany, 6.8 %.

The exit of passenger motor vehicles from Serbia increased by 7.3%, compared with the same period 2008. The exit of vehicles registered in Serbia and Montenegro increased by 14.5%, and in the same period, the exit of vehicles with foreign registration plates increased by 3.2%. The largest number of vehicles was registered in Bosnia and Herzegovina, 18.3%, then come those registered in Croatia, 7.1% and Hungary, 5.9 %.

The largest number of vehicles entered through the border crossings with Bosnia and Herzegovina, 29.4%, and with Croatia, 24.6%. The largest number of vehicles entered Serbia through the Batrovci border crossing, 18%, followed by Horgos, 12.6%, and Presevo, 8%.

The largest number of passengers transport vehicles exited through the border crossings with Bosnia and Herzegovina, 29.6%, and then with Croatia, 24.1%. Three border crossings with the most frequent traffic of passenger transport vehicles in exit from Serbia were: Batrovci, 17%, Horgos, 10.9% and Presevo, 8%.

The total number of passengers that entered Serbia by all modes of transport in 2009 decreased by 1.3% in comparison with the same period 2008. The number of passengers in vehicles registered in Serbia increased by 0.7% and in vehicles with foreign registration plates it decreased by 2.6%. The total number of passengers that exited from Serbia in 2009 increased by 0.7% compared to the same period 2008. The number of passengers in domestic vehicles increased by 2.8%, while the number of passengers in vehicles with foreign registration plates decreased by 0.9%.
