Data on expected production of wheat, early fruit and areas sown with maize, sugar beet, sunflower and soya are presented as of 25/05/2010.

According to the state of crops on the estimation day, production of wheat is expected to amount 1902 thousand tons in the Republic of Serbia, which is by 8.0% less than the production realized in the previous year, and by 8.3% less than ten - year average production (1999-2009).

Referring to fruit, decrease in production is expected for raspberries by 3.2%, cherries by 18.3%, sour-cherries by 30.9% and apricots by 29.2%, when compared to the previous year.

Compared to 10 - year average, decrease in production is expected for cherries by 2.0%, sour-cherries 9.9% and apricots by 0.5%, while production of raspberries is expected to increase by 3.8%.

In 2010, when compared to the previous year and based on preliminary results of the spring sowing, there was an increase of sown maize by 1.9%, sunflower by 7.6%, soya by 15.5% and sugar beet by 5.9%.

Compared to 10 - year average, areas under sunflower are smaller by 2.3%, and areas under maize are larger by 1.7%, under sugar beet by 10.1% and under soya by 28.8%.

Starting from 1999 the Statistical Office of the Republic of Serbia has not at disposal and may not provide available certain data relative to AP Kosovo and Metohia and therefore these data are not included in the coverage for the Republic of Serbia (total).

Final data on spring sowing period 2010 will be available at the end of July.
