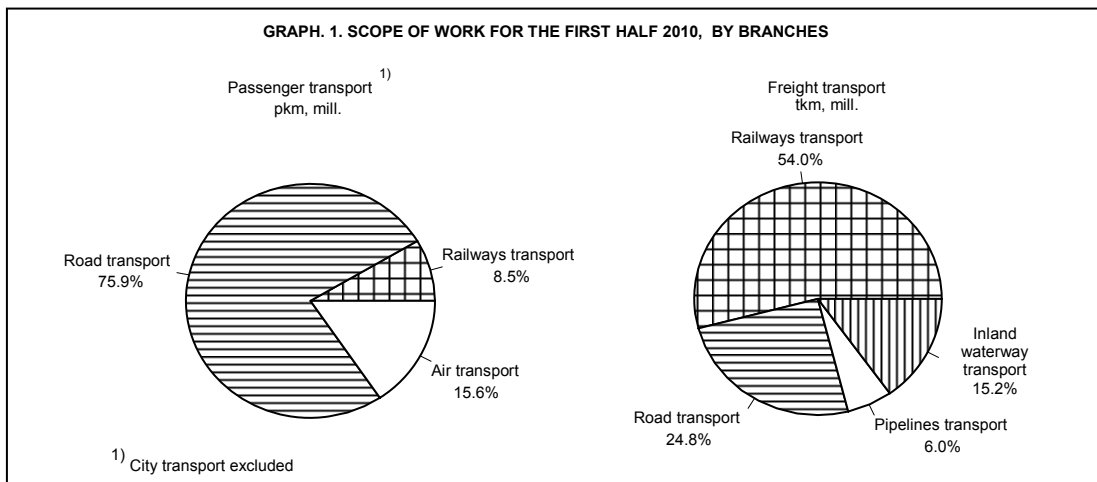

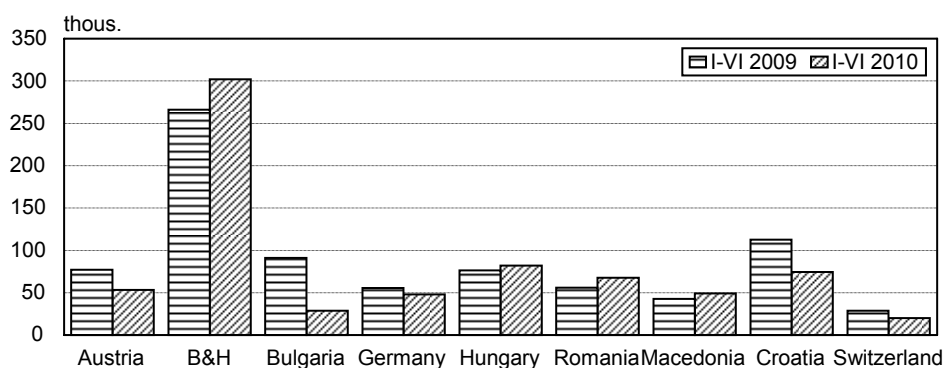

Notes along with the data published

Number of transported passengers in the first six months of 2010 decreased by 11.2% relative to the same period 2009, with the completely different tendencies regarding domestic and international transport. Passengers transport in domestic transport decreased by 11.6%, while in international transport, it increased by 3.5%. Referring to passengers transport, only railway and urban transport record positive growth rates. Operations volume expressed in pkm decreased by 2.6%. Goods transported in the first half of 2010 noted growth of 23.2%, relative to the same period 2009. Regarding the same period, expressed in tkm, operations volume increased by 24.3%. Simultaneously, it is apparent that average ton kilometer increased from 276 km to 279 km. All types of land transport recorded increase in quantity of transported goods, excluding air transport. Transport of goods in air transport, although insignificant when compared to other transport modes, recorded slight decreasing tendency.

Increased number of transported passengers in railway transport in the first half of 2010 amounted to 2.7%. Number of transported passengers decreased by 5.2% in international transport, while it increased by 3.8% in domestic transport. In the same period, goods transport showed the increase in all transport types. Operations volume, expressed in tkm, also noted a 26.2 % growth relative to the same period 2009.

Road passenger transport noted the fall of 12.1%, together with the significant fall of volume operations, expressed in pkm, by 2.9%. Referring to the road transport of goods, there was an increase of 2.5%, as well as operations volume increase of 35.3%, expressed in tkm and relative to the same period 2009.

The oil transport via pipelines decreased by 3.4% regarding the transported oil volume and by 6% regarding the tkm made. The natural gas transport increased by 62.6 %, as well as the operations volume, by 41.6 %.

Air transport expressed negative trends referring to passengers transport. Number of transported passengers decreased by 0.7%, and realized passenger kilometers by 2.7%. Negative growth rates were noted in international transport. Transported goods decreased by 6.1%; moreover, international air transport also recorded exactly the same decrease. Operations volume, expressed in tkm, decreased by 2.3 %, with identical fall in international transport.

Border traffic of road passengers' vehicles decreased by 1.4% in the first half of 2010 if compared to the same period 2009. There were more vehicles with Serbian registration plates than the vehicles with foreign registration plates. Out of the total number of vehicles with foreign registration plates that came into Serbia, 19% referred to those from Bosnia and Herzegovina. Entry and exit of freight vehicles to our country decreased by around 20%. Transit of international freight vehicles increased by 28.3%.

Postal services in the first half of 2010 compared to the same period 2009 noted the following trends: letter mails increased by 1.4%, parcels decreased by 6.5% and payment traffic services remained unchanged.

Total number of the employed in transport decreased by 6.9% respective to the same period of the previous year.
