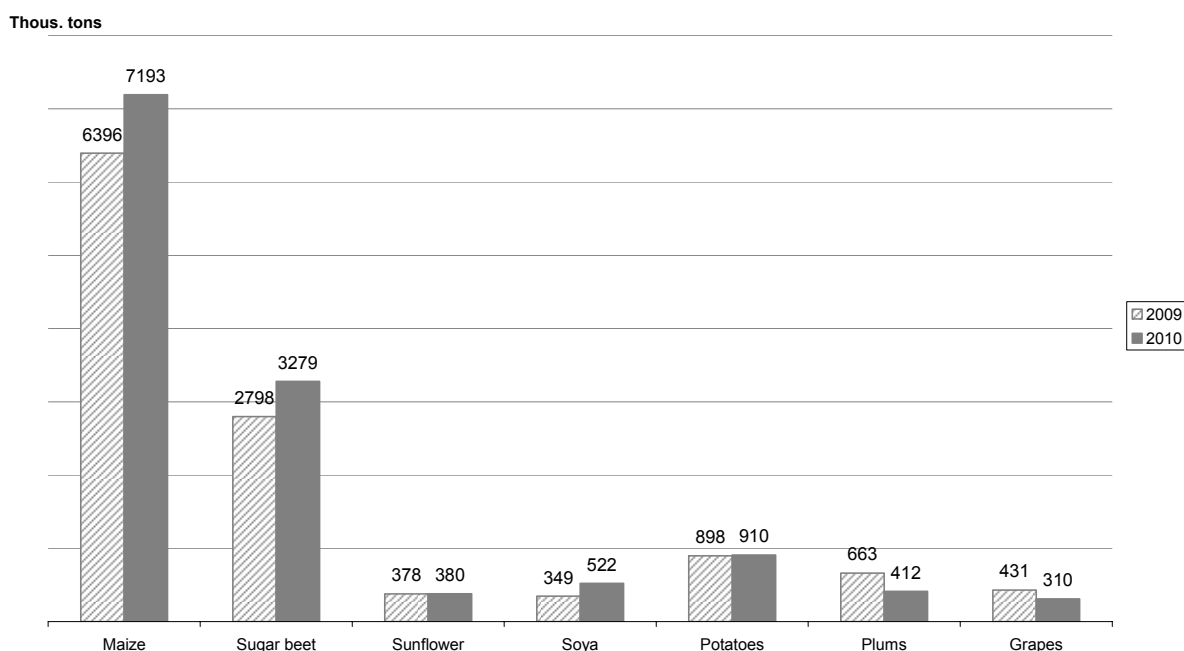

### Notes

The presented data are preliminary results on realized production of maize, sugar beet, sunflower, soya, potatoes, plums and grapes in 2010. Data are gathered by reports for agricultural enterprises and cooperatives and statistical estimations which are conducted by statistical estimators for private agricultural producers.

According to these data, maize production is expected to amount 7193 thousand tones in 2010, which is by 12.5% greater than production in previous year. Compared to 2009, expected production of sugar beet is by 17.2% greater, of sunflower by 0.6%, of soya by 49.5% and of potatoes by 1.3%.

Compared to ten-year average (2000-2009), expected production of maize is greater by 32.3%, of sugar beet by 35.9%, of sunflower by 9.5%, of soya by 76.0% and of potatoes by 5.9%.

Compared to realized production of fruit and grapes in the previous year, smaller production of plums is expected in the Republic of Serbia in 2010, by 37.9% and of grapes by 28.1%. Also, compared to ten-year average, expected production of plums is smaller, by 14.7% and of grapes by 16.9%.

Final data on harvest of late crops and production of fruit and grapes in 2010 will be available at the end of December
