The total number of passenger motor vehicles that entered Serbia in the first nine months of 2010 increased by 6.7%, compared to the same period of the previous year. The number of vehicles registered in our country increased by 20.2%, while the number of vehicles registered abroad remained on the same level. Among foreign vehicles, the largest number was registered in Bosnia and Herzegovina, 12.7%, then in Montenegro, 9.8% and in Croatia, 5.1%.

Exit of passenger motor vehicles from Serbia increased by 14.7%, compared with the same period 2009. Exit of vehicles registered in our country increased by 22.9%, while in the same period, exit of vehicles with foreign registration plates increased by 9.9%. The largest number of vehicles was registered in Bosnia and Herzegovina, 15.1%, then in Montenegro, 9.3% and in Croatia, 6.1%.

The largest number of vehicles entered through the border crossings with Bosnia and Herzegovina, 27.9%, followed by Hungary, 17.9% and Croatia, 15.8%. The largest number of vehicles entered Serbia through Trbusnica border crossing, 7.1%, followed by Batrovci, 6.7% and Mali Zvornik, 5.6%.

The largest number of passengers transport vehicles exited through the border crossings with Bosnia and Herzegovina, 30.3% and then with Croatia, 21.0%. Three border crossings with the most frequent traffic of passenger transport vehicles in exit from Serbia were: Batrovci, 14.2%, Horgos, 10.9% and Trbusnica, 8.8%.

The total number of passengers that entered Serbia by all modes of transport in the first nine months of 2010 increased by 2.8% in comparison with the same period 2009. The number of passengers in vehicles with domestic registration plates decreased by 14.4% and in vehicles with foreign registration plates it increased by 13.6%. The total number of passengers that exited from Serbia in the first nine months of 2010 increased by 6.2% compared to the same period 2009. The number of passengers in domestic vehicles decreased by 13.4%, while the number of passengers in vehicles with foreign registration plates increased by 20.1%.
