## Construction work abroad, 2010

### – Preliminary results –

The total value of works that contractors from the Republic of Serbia performed abroad in 2010 amounted to 13256 mill. RSD. The largest construction activity, observed by countries, was noted in the Montenegro, 17.1% of the total value of works performed . then in Kazakhstan, 15.7%, and in Peru 13.6%.

When observed by type of constructions, in 2010 the value of works done on buildings amounted to 15.3% and to 84.7% for work performed on other civil engineering structures. As to the work on buildings national contractors were most engaged in the Nigeria, while the largest construction activity was noted in civil engineering in Peru.

Construction materials and equipment from the Republic of Serbia were mostly incorporated in Montenegro, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Gabon, the Russian Federation, Norway and France.

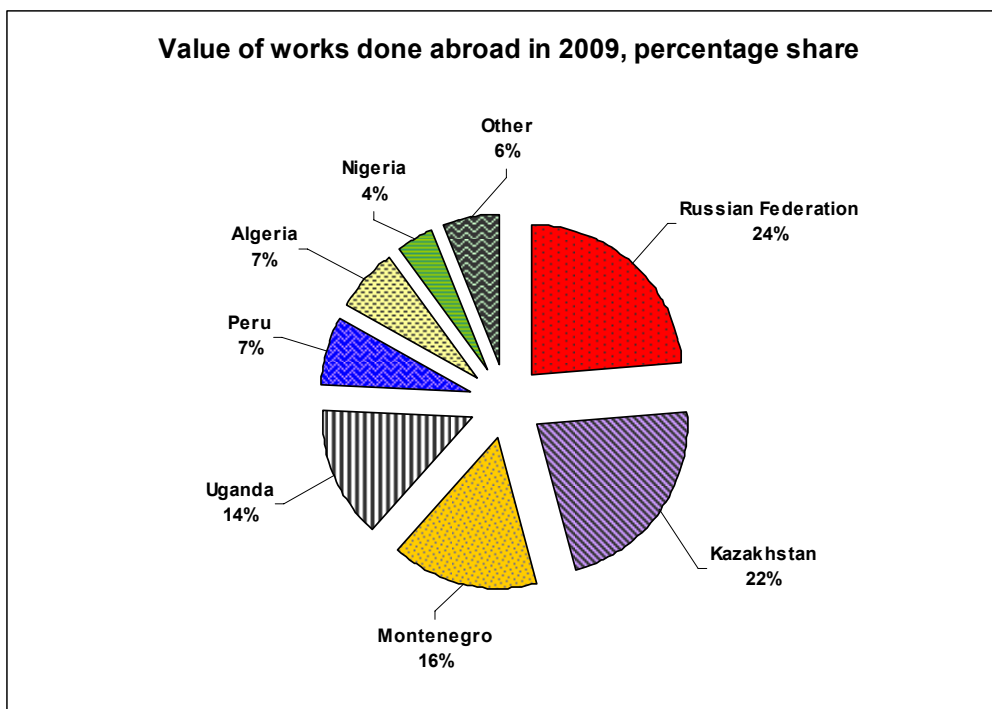
The total number of employees from the Republic of Serbia that were engaged abroad by our contractors amounted to 2172. Most of them worked in the Russian Federation and Montenegro, while 3 to 158 workers were employed in other countries.

In 2010 most of works were contracted in the Kazakhstan, followed by Uganda, Montenegro, Peru and Nigeria.

### Methodological notes

The data presented in the table are collected through the Annual Survey on Works Abroad, works performed by enterprises from the Republic of Serbia which undertake construction works abroad.

**Value of contracted works** presents the value of contracts signed in the reference year with the client. **Value of works done** is the value of works exported by the reference unit in selected countries during the reference year for which it engages its permanent labour force as well as temporary workers. The value of works contracted and done in the reference year is calculated according to the mean exchange rate of USD or EUR, which is published in the exchange rate list of the National Bank of Serbia established as of 31/12 of the previous year, regardless of the current exchange rate of USD or EUR to dinar.

**Value of construction materials consumed and equipment incorporated from the Republic of Serbia** is the value of materials and equipment incorporated which were consumed abroad during the reference year. The data contained in the total value of works done does not include the value of materials and equipment consumed, which the enterprise purchased abroad. **Average number of employees on building sites from the Republic of Serbia** is the average number of employees from the Republic of Serbia engaged by the reporting units for the purpose of performing works abroad. **Total hours worked of employees** from the Republic of Serbia present the total number of hours actually worked on building sites abroad as regards employees from the Republic of Serbia.

For more methodological explanations on this survey refer to the edition of SORS "Methodologies and Standards: Monthly Surveys on Building Permits, volume 27, and Classification of Constructions Types, volume 15.

Since 1999, the Statistical Office of the Republic of Serbia doesn't dispose of certain data for AP Kosovo and Metohia, so they are not contained in the data coverage for the Republic of Serbia (total).
