

REPUBLIC OF SERBIA





Methodological notes

The total number of transported passengers in 2010, relative to the previous year, decreased by 7.8% and it is notable that in domestic transport we saw a significant decrease of 8.4%. An increase of 9.2% was recorded in international transport. A decrease of the number of passengers carries is notable in road and railway transport contrary to public transport in which positive growth rate has been recorded. The total performance expressed in pkm increased by 1.5%, the domestic transport of passengers falling by 3.8%, and the international transport growing by 15.7%. The highest increase in pkm traveled of 3.2%, relative to the previous year, was noted in air transport.

The volume of transported goods in 2010, relative to the previous year, increased by 13.6%, with a simultaneous operations volume growth of 22.3%, expressed in tkm. These trends indicate an increased average ton kilometer: from 245.3 km in 2009 to 260.7 km in 2010. A larger quantity of goods in 2010, relative to 2009, was transported by all modes of transport, except in air transport which recorded a fall of 3.8%.

The number of transported passengers in railway transport, relative to the previous year, noted a fall of 1.7% and the performance expressed in pkm was at the same level. The domestic passenger transport saw a considerably faster decrease of performance than the international passenger transport. The quantity of goods carried is smaller in all modes of goods railway transport, except in imports, where the level remained the same.

The total number of passenger carried in railway transport decreased, relative to the previous year, by 8.4%, the international passenger transport noting a growth of 21.4%. The total number of passengers carried in domestic transport decreased by 8.7%. The total volume of operations, shown in pkm, grew by 1.5%, in passenger transport it decreased by 3.4%, and in international passenger transport it increased by 51.6%. The total quantity of goods carried in road transport in 2010, in relation to 2009, increased by 9.2%. The volume of operations, in tkm, increased by 42.5% which is indicative of a longer average journey.

The oil pipeline transport increased by 1.4%. In the same period, natural gas pipeline transport grew by 27.3%. The volume of operations, in tkm, is lower by 5.2% as far as crude oil transport is concerned, and higher by 18.5% in natural gas pipeline transport.

Air transport, as far as passengers carried and total operations volume are concerned, indicates growth. Transported passengers' number, compared to the previous year, increased by 3.2%, and total operations volume by 20.%. When we observe goods transport, the situation in air transport is totally different. Namely, in 2010, when compared to 2009, we can notice a fall of quantities of goods transported, of 3.8%, and a growth of total operations volume of 2.4%.

The border traffic of road passenger vehicles coming into Serbia increased by 3.1% in 2010 if compared to 2009. The number of vehicles with national registration plates increased by 16.8%, and that of vehicles with foreign registration plates decreased by 3.6%. The number of freight vehicles which entered the national territory, increased over the same period by 32.7%, and those which exited from it by 43.5%. Transit throughout the Republic of Serbia was higher by 67.1%.

The total number of services in fixed telephony has been measured since 2010, in relation to 2009, according to a new measurement unit – the minute. The initial communications in mobile telephony increased by 11.9%, and SMS by 14.0%.

Classic mailing, i.e. postal services in 2010, compared to 2009, noted the following movements: letter mails increased by 3.9%, parcels decreased by 16.2% and payment traffic services increased by 3.6%. The volume of services in fixed telephony increased by 11.9%, and SMS by 14.0%.

The total number of employees decreased by 5.5% in relation to the previous year.
