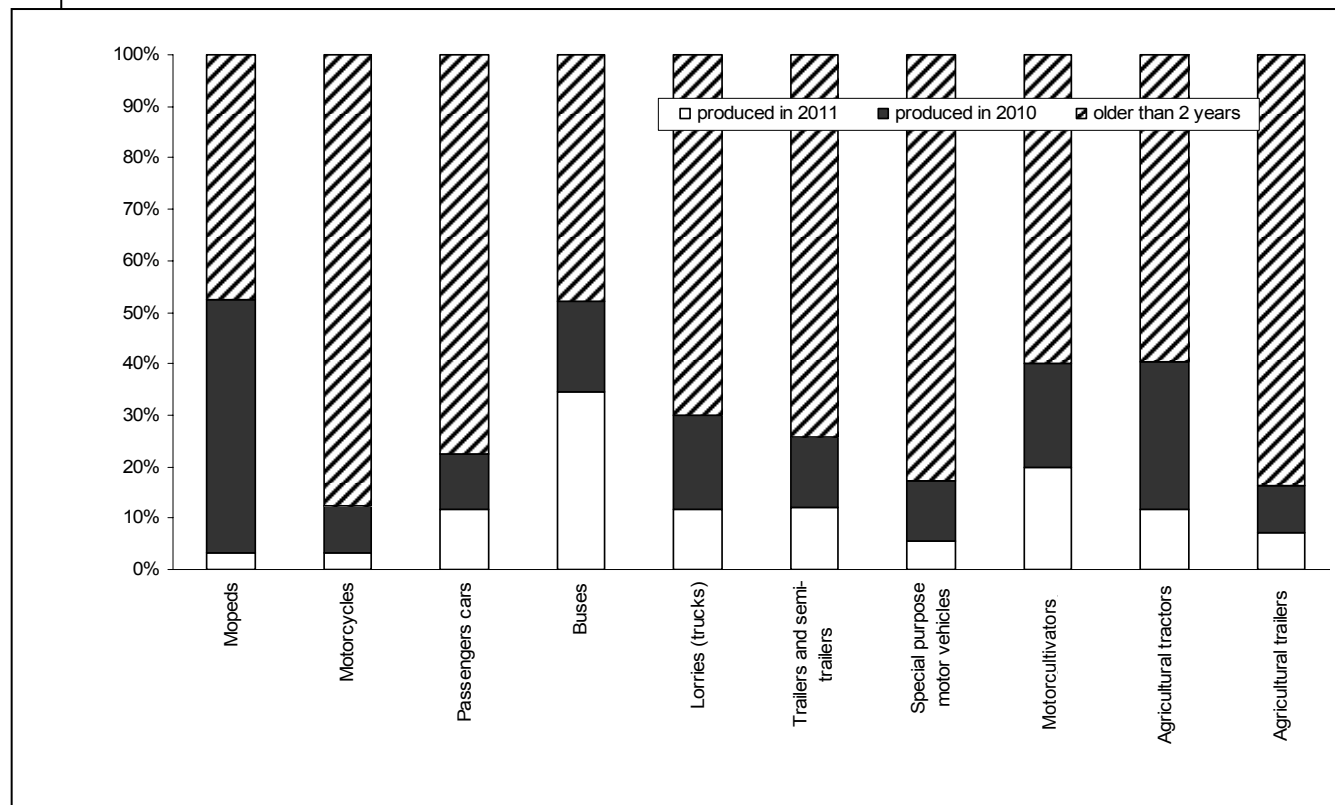

The number of buses registered for the first time in the first quarter of 2011 in the Republic of Serbia increased by 4.2% and the number of passenger cars decreased by 27.6%, when compared to the same period 2010. The greatest number of road motor vehicles was produced by the following manufacturers: Zastava (domestic trademark) and Fiat, Renault, Opel, and VW (foreign trademarks).

It is to be noted that, due to methodology changes regarding the observed vehicles by the Ministry of the Interior, the data are not fully comparable with previously published ones.

The total number of injury road accidents in the first quarter of 2011 increased by 20.6%, when compared to the same period 2010. The greatest increase of injury accidents with killed persons, by 35.4%, was recorded within built-up areas.

The number of casualties in the first quarter of 2011 increased by 23.1% respective to the same period 2010, while number of injured persons in settlements increased by 27.4%.
