**Labor Force Survey, April 2011****- Preliminary results -****Introductory notes**

Labor Force Survey represents a study survey that most completely considers the labor force status and fluctuations in the labor market.


In this survey, we applied the methodological solutions harmonized with the recommendations and definitions of the International Labor Organization (ILO) and the requirements by Eurostat (Statistical Office of the European Communities) and thereby the most important source was obtained for the international comparison of data of the Republic of Serbia and other countries, regarding the field of labor statistics. The frame for the sample selection is based on the 2002 Census of population, households and dwellings.

The survey covered about 8000 households on the territory of the Republic of Serbia. The data were collected relative to the demographic features of the whole population. For the population aged 15 and above, the data on their working activity were also collected. The total of 23029 persons were interviewed and for 20277 persons the data regarding their working activity were obtained, which equals to 0.3% of the total number of persons aged 15 and above.

Since 1999 no data for the AP Kosovo and Metohija are available for the Statistical Office of the Republic of Serbia, and they are not included in the coverage for the Republic of Serbia (total).

The Labor Force Survey was carried out in April 2011 and the period of observation extended from 4-10 April 2011.


**Structure of active population aged 15 and above, April 2011 (percentage)**






**Structure of population aged 15 and above by occupational status (percentage), April 2011


**Structure of population aged 15 and above by activity and sex, April 2011 (percentage)**















## Main Definitions

The Labor Force Survey observes population aged 15 and above relative to the activity in the respective week and not according to formal employment status of the persons interviewed.

The term **employed** here anticipates the persons who did a job for at least one hour in the respective week and were duly remunerated (payments in money or in kind), as well as the persons who were employed and were absent from work in the observed week.

**Family workers** are the persons rendered assistance, i.e. service to other household members in running family business or agricultural holding and were not remunerated for their work.

The term **unemployed** refers to the persons who, in the respective week did not perform any work for remuneration and who did not have a job they were absent from and which they could carry on after the absence, under the conditions as follows:

- In the last four weeks these persons undertook active steps to find job and if a job was offered, they would be able to start working in two weeks time;
- In the last four weeks these persons undertook no active steps to find job, since they had already found a job and were about to start working after the respective week, latest within the following three-month period.

**Active population (labor force)** includes all employed and unemployed persons aged 15 and above.

**Inactive population** anticipates the persons aged 15 and above that were not categorized as active population.

**Activity rate** presents the percentage share of active population in total population aged 15 and above.

**Employment rate** presents the percentage share of employed population in total population aged 15 and above.

**Unemployment rate** presents the percentage share of unemployed population in total number of active population.

**Inactivity rate** presents the percentage share of inactive population in total population aged 15 and above.

**Long-term unemployment rate** anticipates the percentage share of those unemployed for one year and more, in the total number of active population.

**Share of long-term unemployment** is the percentage share of those unemployed for one year and more in the total number of unemployed population.
