
Social welfare beneficiaries in the Republic of Serbia, 2010

During 2010, in the group of children and youth (aged up to 18, that is 26), 27.7% of children and youth became passive (or left the social welfare system), while 35.8%, that is somewhat over a third part of the recorded number of children during the year, entered or came back to the social welfare system.

Regarding the total number of adult beneficiaries (aged 18-60, that is 65) during 2010, 26.1% of social welfare beneficiaries became passive (or left the social welfare system), while 36.8% of total number of adult beneficiaries entered or came back to the social welfare system during the year.

Referring to the group of old people (aged 60, that is 65 and over), 21.9% of them became inactive cases during 2010 (or left the social welfare system), while 28.4% of total number of persons in this category entered or came back to the system of social welfare in 2010.
