Total transport of passengers and goods, 2010 and 2011

– Republic of Serbia –

The total number of transported passengers in 2011, relative to the previous year, decreased by 2.2% and it is notable that in domestic transport we saw a decrease of 2.5%. An increase of 6.6% was recorded in international transport. A decrease of 3.8% in the number of passengers carried is notable in road and railway transport records an increase of 16.2% in the number of passengers carried. In public transport a positive growth rate of 2.6% has been recorded. The total performance expressed in pkm increased by 4.4%, the domestic transport of passengers being up by 2.7%, and the international transport by 7.9%. The highest increase in pkm traveled of 28.7%, relative to the previous year, was noted in air transport.

The volume of transported goods in 2011, relative to the previous year, decreased by 4.9%, with a simultaneous operations volume growth of 3.4%, expressed in tkm. These trends indicate an increased average ton kilometer in land transport: from 260.3 km in 2010 to 283.0 km in 2011. A smaller quantity of goods in 2011, relative to 2010, was transported by road, pipelines and air. An increase of goods transported of 9.9% was recorded in inland waterways transport.

The number of transported passengers in railway transport, relative to the previous year, noted a growth of 16.2% and the performance expressed in pkm increased by 3.6%. Faster growth of the performance was recorded in the international passenger transport than in the domestic passenger transport. The quantity of goods carried is larger in domestic goods transport, as well as in goods transit in railway transport, except in imports and exports, where decrease was recorded.

The total number of passenger carried in road transport decreased, relative to the previous year, by 3.8%, the international passenger transport noting a fall of 6.3%. The total number of passengers carried in domestic transport decreased by 3.8%. The total volume of operations, shown in pkm, grew by 3.1% in domestic transport, and in international passenger transport it decreased by 20.0%. The total quantity of goods carried in road transport in 2011, in relation to 2010, decreased by 17.8%. The volume of operations, in tkm, increased by 12.9% which is indicative of a longer average journey.

Oil pipeline transport decreased by 11.6%. In the same period, natural gas pipeline transport grew by 8.1%. The volume of operations, in tkm, is lower by 18.6% as far as crude oil transport is concerned, and higher by 11.3% in natural gas pipeline transport.

Air transport, as far as passengers carried and total operations volume are concerned, indicates growth. Transported passengers' number, compared to the previous year, increased by 18.2%, and total operations volume by 22.5%. When we observe goods transport, the situation in air transport is totally different. Namely, in 2011, when compared to 2010, we can notice a fall of quantities of goods transported, of 6.8%, and a growth of total operations volume of 0.4%.

The border traffic of road passenger vehicles coming into Serbia decreased by 2.3% in 2011 if compared to 2010. The number of vehicles with national registration plates decreased by 4.3%, and that of vehicles with foreign registration plates decreased by 1.1%. The number of freight vehicles which entered the national territory, decreased over the same period by 20.5%, and those which exited it by 20.9%. Transit throughout the Republic of Serbia was down by 21.9%.

The volume of services in fixed telephony has been measured since 2010 according to a new measurement unit – the minute. The initial communications in mobile telephony increased by 15.3%, and SMS decreased by 1.1%.

Classic mailing, i.e. postal services in 2011, compared to 2010, noted the following movements: letter mails increased by 3.4%, parcels decreased by 0.7% and payment traffic services decreased by 0.3%.

The total number of employees decreased by 5.7% in relation to the previous year.




Graph. 1. Scope of work, by branches, 2011 - Republic of Serbia -


