Statistics of Transport and Communications

Total transport of passengers and goods - Republic of Serbia -

First half of 2012

Number of transported passengers in the first six months of 2012 increased by 0.5% relative to the same period 2011 with the same tendencies regarding domestic and international transport: passengers transport in domestic transport increased by 0.4%, and in international transport 2.6%. Referring to passengers railway transport, decrease of 10.4% was noted and in road, urban and air transport, recorded were positive growth rates. Operations volume, expressed in pkm, decreased by 0.5%. Goods transported in the first half of 2012 noted fall of 13.1%, relative to the same period 2011. Regarding the same period, expressed in tkm, operations volume decreased by 13.2%. Simultaneously, it is apparent that average ton kilometer amounted to 289 km. Only transport of goods in road transport recorded the increasing tendency.

Decreased number of transported passengers in railway transport in the first half of 2012 amounted to 10.4%. Number of transported passengers in domestic and international transport decreased by about 10.0%. In the same period goods transport showed the decrease 28.9%, operations volume, expressed in tkm, also noted 26.7 % fall relative to the same period 2011.

Road passenger transport noted the growth of 1.3%, together with the insignificant growth of volume operations, by 0.6%. Referring to the road transport of goods, there was an increase of 10.7%, as well as operations volume increase of 19.2%, expressed in tkm and relative to the same period 2011.

The oil transport via pipelines decreased by 3.7% regarding the transported oil volume and by 9.7% regarding the tkm made. The natural gas transport increased by 5.8 %, and the operations volume decreased by 6.8 %.

Air transport expressed positive trends referring to passengers transport. Number of transported passengers increased by 10.0%, and realized passenger kilometers by 1.2%. Negative growth rates were noted in domestic and international transport of goods. Transported goods decreased by 15.8% and operations volume, expressed in tkm, decreased by 16.1 %.

Border traffic of entering road passengers' vehicles decreased by 1.0% in the first half of 2012 if compared to the same period 2011. There were somewhat less vehicles both with Serbian registration plates and with foreign registration plates. Out of the total number of vehicles with foreign registration plates that came into Serbia, 11.3% referred to those from Bosnia and Herzegovina. Entry of freight vehicles to our country decreased by 15.6%, while exit noted increase of 15.1%. Transit increased by 4.8%.

Postal services in the first half of 2012 compared to the same period 2011 noted the following trends: letter mails increased by 9.5%, parcels increased by 20.2% and payment traffic services decreased by 3.4%.

Fixed telephony noted decrease of 14,5%, and mobile telephony increase of 25.7%.

Total number of the employed in transport increased by 1.5% respective to the same period of the previous year.




