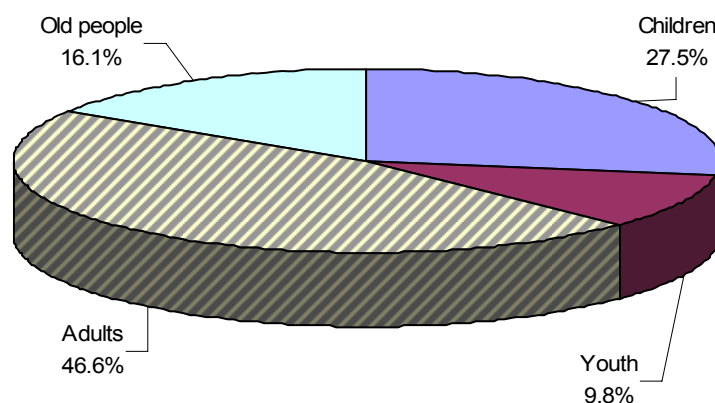
## Social welfare beneficiaries in the Republic of Serbia, 2011

In 2011, in the group of children (persons aged 0 – 17), 54% of total number of beneficiaries related to boys and 46% to girls. Children of this age group presented 27% of total number of social welfare beneficiaries. Regarding the group of the young (persons aged 18-25), 52% related to male beneficiaries and 48% to female ones. In relation to total number of social welfare beneficiaries, this category presented 10% of all social welfare beneficiaries.

In the group of adults (aged 26-64), 47% related to males and 53% to females. This category involved 47% of total number of social welfare beneficiaries.

Regarding the oldest group of population (persons aged 65 and over), male persons presented 37% and female ones 63%. In relation to total number of social welfare beneficiaries, this category encompassed 16%.

### Methodological explanation

Data on social welfare beneficiaries and conducted forms, measures and services of social welfare have been, since 2010, taken over from the Republic Institute for Social Protection. Due to methodology changes regarding data collection, new categories of social welfare beneficiaries have been introduced since 2011, differing from the categories of beneficiaries in the previous years.

Beneficiary of social welfare is taken to be every person that, during the reporting year, once or several times, used certain forms and measures of social welfare and services of social work.
