
## Irrigation in Republic of Serbia, 2012

## - Preliminary data -


During 2012, total water abstracted for irrigation was 110 445 thous. m<sup>3</sup>, of which most was pumped from rivers (91%), while the rest was abstracted from the groundwater, lakes and reservoirs and from public water supply network.

Starting from 1999 the Statistical Office of the Republic of Serbia has not at disposal and may not provide available certain data relative to AP Kosovo and Metohija and therefore these data are not included in the coverage for the Republic of Serbia (total).

Graph 2. Total irrigation waters in the Republic of Serbia, 2007-2012





Graph 3. Irrigated areas by irrigation type in the Republic of Serbia, 2012



In 2012, 94 532 ha were covered by irrigation systems of which irrigated area was 52 986 ha, and the most frequent type of irrigation, as in the previous year, was sprinkling irrigation. Out of total irrigated area, 90% was irrigated by sprinkling irrigation, while both the surface irrigation and irrigation drop by drop covered 5% of the irrigated area, each.
