# Number of livestock in the Republic of Serbia As of 01.12.2015

- Preliminary results -


According to the data presented in this statistical release, in the Republic of Serbia, as of December 1<sup>st</sup> 2015 and relative to the previous results, total number of pigs increased by 1.5%, of sheep by 2.3% and of poultry by 1.6%, while the number of cattle decreased by 0.5%, of goats by 7.2% and the number of horses by 2.5%.

Cattle breeding is the most frequent in Region Sumadije i Zapadne Srbije (47.2%), in relation to total number of cattle on the territory of the Republic of Serbia and pigs raising is the most common in Region Vojvodine (40.9%).

Compared to ten-annual average (2005-2014), total number of cattle decreased by 8.1%, of pigs by 4.8%, of goats by 16.3%, of horses by 9.6%, and of poultry by 4.2%, while total number of sheep increased by 13.4% and of goats by 33.9%.

Final data on livestock number, by types and categories, as well as data on livestock balance and livestock production will be published in April of the current year.

#### Methodological notes

Data for 2015 are obtained on the basis of conducting the Survey on agricultural production – Animal production, sample based. Sample selection was done according to the data from the Statistical register of agricultural holdings. Single-stage stratified sample covered 1.5% of agricultural holdings, i.e. 8 971 family holdings, 584 holdings of legal entities and 142 holdings of unincorporated enterprises.

Territorial distribution was done in compliance with the Regulation on the Nomenclature of Statistical Territorial Units ("Official Gazette of RS", No 109/09 and 46/10).

Starting from 1999 the Statistical Office of the Republic of Serbia has not at disposal and may not provide available certain data relative to AP Kosovo and Metohija and therefore these data are not included in the coverage for the Republic of Serbia (total).
