## Total transport of passengers and goods

## First half of 2017

Number of transported passengers in the first six months of 2017 decreased by 8.3% relative to the same period 2016. Passengers transport in domestic transport decreased by 9.3% and number of passengers in international transport increased by 6.5%. Referring to passengers railway transport, decrease of 8.5% was noted, in public transport, increase of 18.6% was noted, resulting from changed methodology of counting transport in the city of Belgrade, meaning that data are not comparable with the previous period. In air transport, increase of 3.4% was recorded, while in road transport, recorded was the decrease of 8.7%. Operations volume, expressed in pkm, increased by 7.7%. Goods transported in the first half of 2017 noted growth of 4.4%, relative to the same period 2016. Regarding the same period, expressed in tkm, operations volume increased by 9.0%. Simultaneously, it is apparent that average ton kilometre amounted to 336 km. Only river transport of goods recorded the decreasing tendency.

Decreased number of transported passengers in railway transport in the first half of 2017 amounted to 8.5%. Recorded was the decreased number of transported passengers in domestic transport by 8.3%, while in international transport, the decrease of 13% was noted. In the same period goods transport showed the increase of 10%. Operations volume, expressed in tkm, noted increase of 12.4% relative to the same period 2016.

Road passenger transport noted the fall of 8.7%, and volume operations growth of 3.1%. Referring to the road transport of goods, there was an increase of 7.6%, and operations volume noted increase of 14.5%, expressed in tkm and relative to the same period 2016.

The oil transport via pipelines decreased by 8.1% regarding the transported oil quantities and it decreased by 8.4% regarding the tkm made. The natural gas transport increased by 28.7%, with the simultaneous operations volume increase of 28.6%.

Inland waterways transport noted decrease regarding transported quantities of goods, by 38.5% and regarding operations volume expressed in tkm, it decreased by 29.0%.

Air transport expressed positive trends referring to passengers transport. Number of transported passengers increased by 3.4%, and realized passenger kilometres increased by 20.9%. Transported goods increased by 69.3% and operations volume, expressed in tkm, increased by 295.5%.

Border traffic of entering road passengers' vehicles increased by 2.2% in the first half of 2017 if compared to the same period 2016. Recorded was the slight increase of number of vehicles with Serbian registration plates. Out of the total number of vehicles with foreign registration plates that came into Serbia, 8.0% referred to those from Hungary.

Postal services in the first half of 2017 compared to the same period 2016 noted the following trends: letter mails increased by 5.0%, parcels increased by 78.3%, while payment traffic services decreased by 4.2%.

Fixed telephony noted decrease of 14.4%, and mobile telephony increase of 1.0%.

Total number of the employed in transport section decreased by 2.9% respective to the same period of the previous year.



### Graph.1. Scope of work for the first half 2017, by branches Republic of Serbia


