Input price indices in agriculture, III Quarter 2017

Input prices in agriculture in III Quarter 2017 in relation to II Quarter 2017 were decreased by 0.9% on average. Prices in III Quarter 2017 were decreased by 1.8% in relation to III Quarter 2016.

Observed by main product groups in III Quarter 2017 in relation to the previous quarter, the fall in prices was noted in the groups Seeds (-15.7%), Fertilizers (-6.1%) and Maintenance of buildings (-4.9%). The rise in prices was noted in the groups Energy (5.7%) and Maintenance of materials (5.2%).

Prices of other products weren't significantly changed.

Methodological explanations

The aim of the survey is the calculation of input price indices in agriculture. Data have been collected since 2012, while price indices have been published since 2014.

Data are published 45 days after the end of the guarter, in the edition Statistical Release, with the mark CN43, and they are also presented on the website of the Statistical Office of the Republic of Serbia (www.stat.gov.rs).
