## Input price indices in agriculture, I Quarter 2018

Input prices in agriculture in I Quarter 2018 in relation to IV Quarter 2017 were decreased by 0.3% on average. Prices in I Quarter 2018 were increased by 1.4% in relation to I Quarter 2017.

Observed by main product groups in I Quarter 2018 in relation to the previous quarter, the fall in prices was noted in the groups Pesticides (-3.4%), Animal feedingstuffs (-1.9%) and Fertilizers (-1.7%). The rise in prices was noted in the groups Seeds (6.9%) and Energy (1.9%).

Prices of other products weren't significantly changed.
