REGISTERED ROAD MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAILERS AND **ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS, 2017**

The number of road motor vehicles registered in 2017 in the Republic of Serbia increased in comparison to the number of registered vehicles in the previous year, by 7.9%. The increase was noted for all sorts of vehicles.

Among domestic trademarks, the largest number of registered passenger cars was produced by Zastava trademark. Regarding foreign trademarks, the following manufacturers were the most notable: Volkswagen, Opel, Ford, Fiat, Renault, Mercedes, Peugeot and Skoda.

The number of first time registered passenger cars in 2017 in the Republic of Serbia decreased by 4.0%, relative to the previous year, the number of buses by 32.9%, of lorries by 4.6%, motorcycles by 31.8% and of trailers and semi-trailers by 21.2%, of mopeds by 46.2% and special purpose motor vehicles by 55.9%.

Based on the results, it can be concluded that the most frequent vehicles were lorries (trucks) of the load capacity from 1500 to 4999 kg, as well as that the majority of such vehicles was with Eurodiesel motor energy, indicating the rejuvenation of the fleet that is in accordance with the latest European regulations.

Regarding the recently manufactured passengers' vehicles, the most dominant were the vehicles of the engine size of up to 2000 cm³, and observed in percentages, the number of vehicles with diesel motor energy prevailed over those with petrol motor energy.

The total number of injury road accidents in 2017 increased by 2.1% when compared to 2016. Greater number of accidents was noted within built-up areas and equalled 81.4%, relative to total number of injury road accidents.

The number of casualties in 2017 increased by 2.4% relative to 2016.
