# Quarterly Gross Domestic Product in the Republic of Serbia – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2019 –

The real GDP growth in the third quarter of 2019, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, amounted 4.8%.

According to seasonally adjusted GDP data, gross domestic product increased by 2.2% in the third quarter of 2019, compared to the previous quarter.

Observed by activities, in the third quarter of 2019, compared to the same quarter of the previous year, significant real growth in the gross value added was recorded in the section of construction -34.7%, the section of information and communication -7.7% and the section of wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles; transportation and storage and accommodation and food service activities -5.4%.

Observed by expenditure aggregates, in the third quarter of 2019, compared to the same quarter of the previous year, real growth was noted as follows: the household final consumption expenditure -3.1%, the non-profit institutions serving households (NPISH) final consumption expenditure -2.3%, the general government final consumption expenditure -4.6%, gross fixed capital formation -17.3%, the exports of goods and services -10.2% and the import of goods and services -11.4%.

Starting from 1999 the Statistical Office of the Republic of Serbia has not at disposal and may not provide available data relative to AP Kosovo and Metohia and therefore these data are not included in the coverage for the Republic of Serbia.
