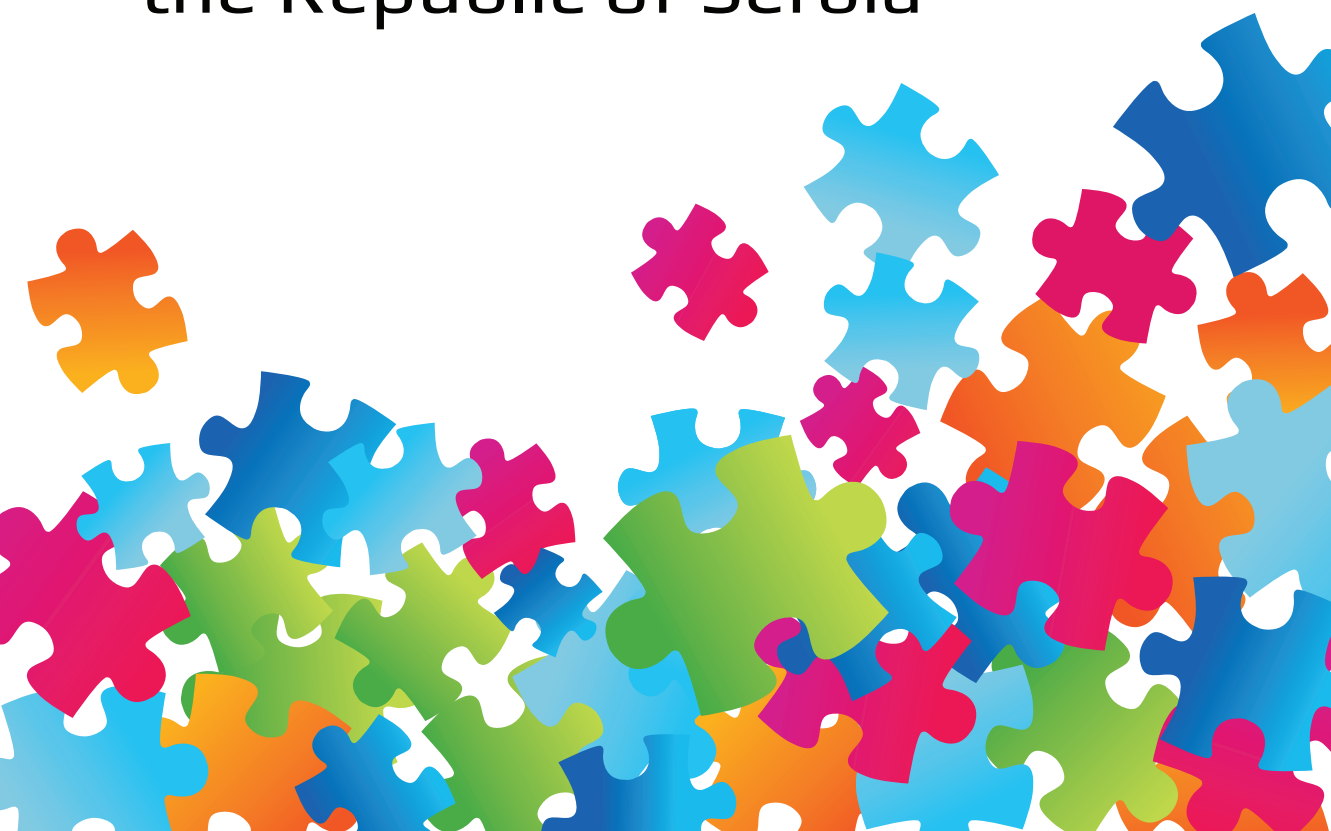

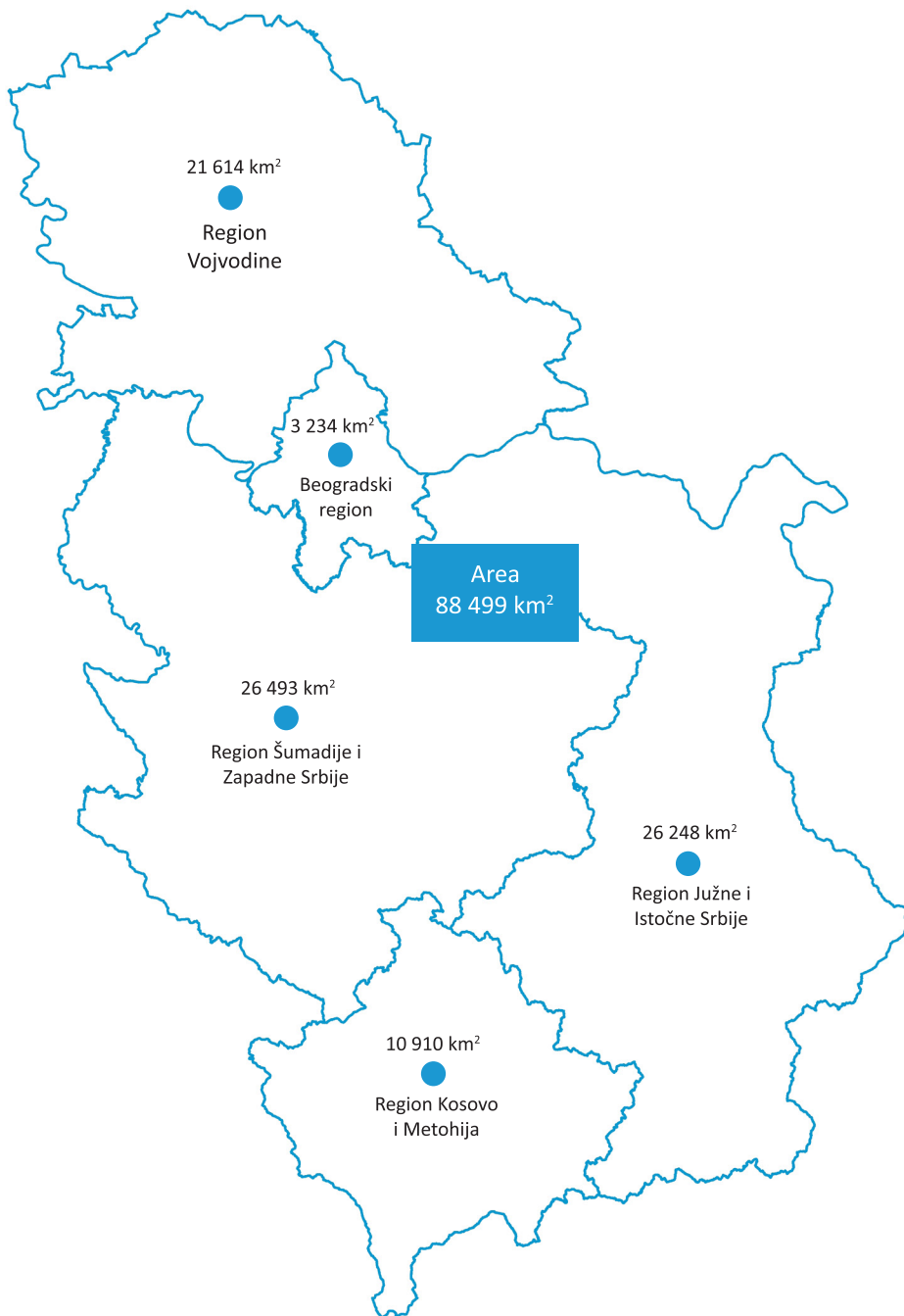
The balanced regional development, namely less expressive discrepancies in the GDP level and other measures of the economic and social development are of crucial importance for the long-term and sustainable overall development of the Republic of Serbia. The indispensable prerequisites for the anticipation and monitoring of the regional progress are reliable, scientifically grounded and internationally comparable statistical indicators; thereby acknowledged is the importance of SORS as the major information system for taking planning and strategic decisions in the domain of regional development.

Therefore, this publication may be regarded as another contribution that SORS makes in ensuring the information and data seen as essential for the domain of regional development, which are expected to find their way not only to the academic community and experts, but also to the widest range of readers interested in the issues related to the Serbian regional development.

Starting from 1999 SORS cannot provide available certain data for AP Kosovo and Metohija; therefore, they are not included in the data coverage for the Republic of Serbia – total.

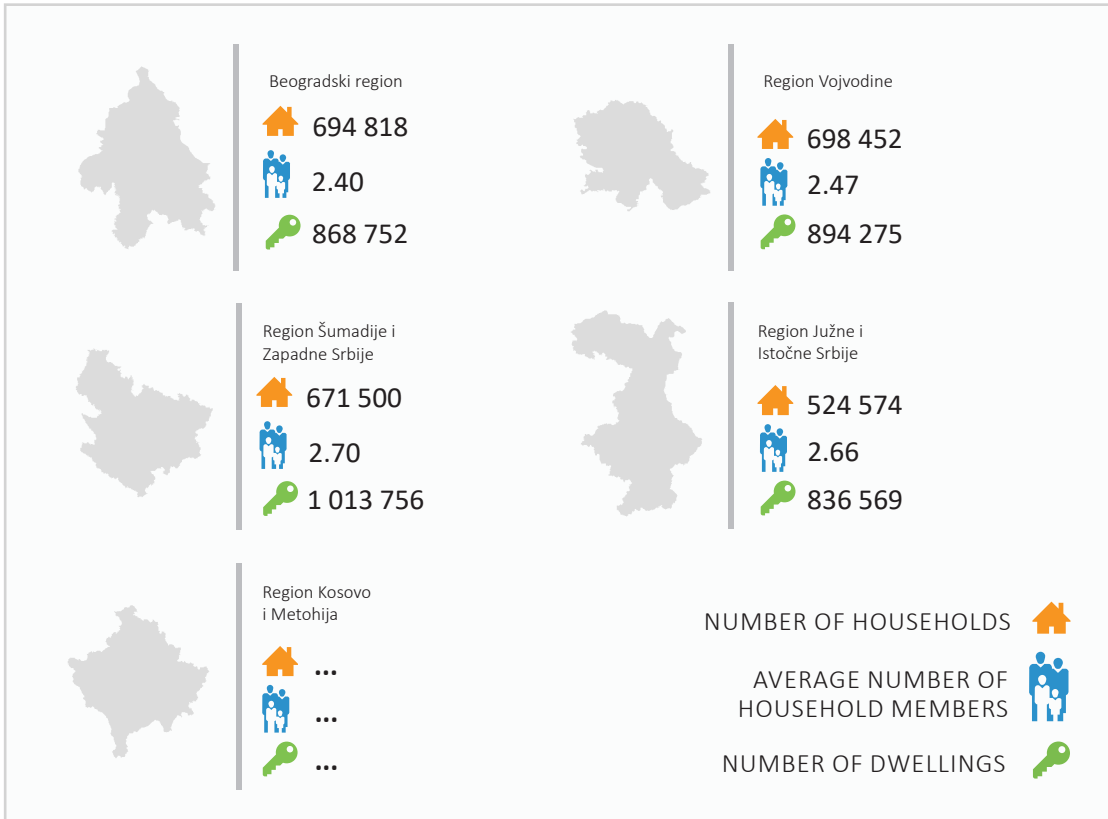
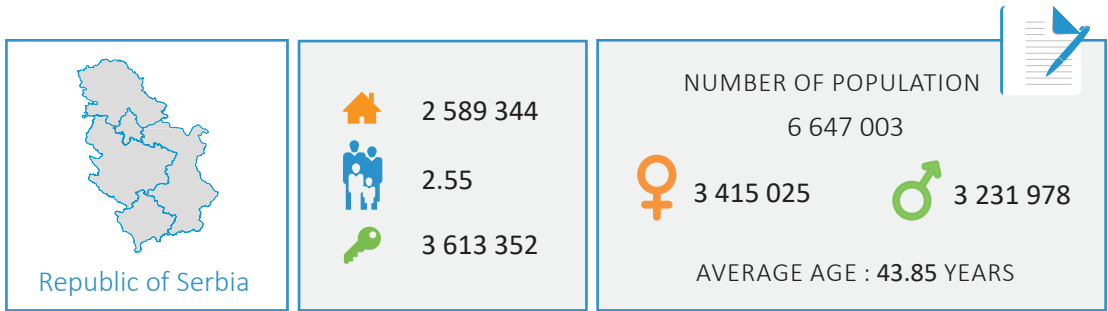


2022 CENSUS OF POPULATION, HOUSEHOLDS AND DWELLINGS

The data of the 2022 Census of Population, Households and Dwellings indicate that there are 6 647 003 inhabitants, 2 589 244 households and 3 613 352 dwellings in the Republic of Serbia.

Somewhat more than one half of the population are females – 3 415 025 (51.4%), while the number of males is 3 231 978 (48.6%).

Observed by the regions, the largest number of population lives in Region Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije – 1 819 318 (27.4%), while the smallest number of population is found in Region Južne i Istočne Srbije – 1 406 050 (21.2%)

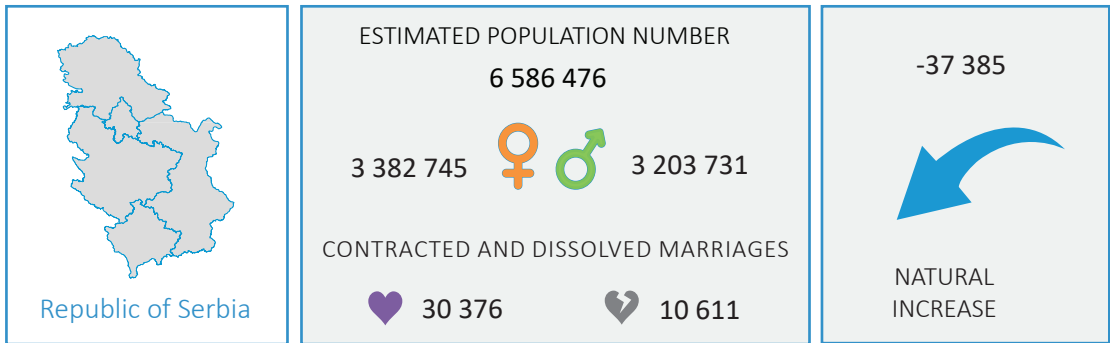
POPULATION, 2024

The estimated number of population in the midyear amounted to 6 586 476. The natural increase rate equalled -5.7%, the birth rate equalled 9.2‰ and the death rate/mortality equalled 14.9‰. The average age of population was 44.0 years.

In 2024 the life expectancy for males was 73.7 years and for women 78.3 years.

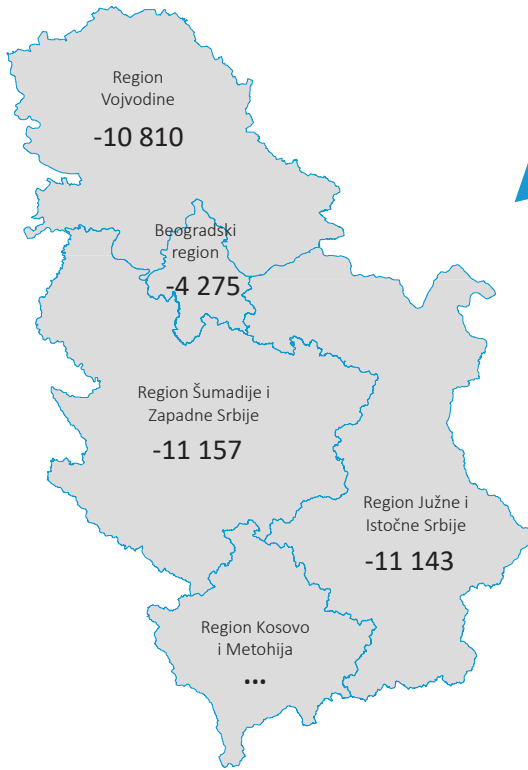
The average age of mother the first-time giving livebirth was 29.1 years.

The leading death causes both for male and for female population were bloodstream diseases.

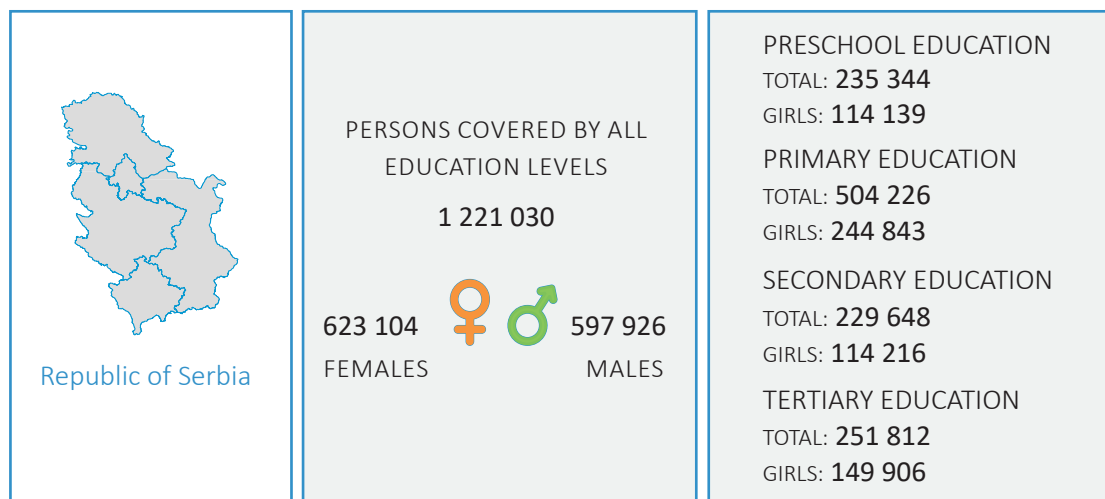
EDUCATION, 2024



In 2024 the number of 1 221 030 persons attended or participated in some level of education. The share of children that attended preschool education was 19.3%, the share for primary education equalled 41.3%, for secondary 18.8%, and for tertiary education expressed the share of 20.6%.

Regarding the generation coverage by various education levels, the coverage of children covered by programme of preschool education equals about 68.8%, while the coverage by the compulsory preparatory preschool programme equals 96.2%. As for primary education, which is also compulsory, the generation coverage equals 97.5%. The generation coverage by secondary education is about 87.4%, and the generation coverage by tertiary education equals 61.6%.

The share of private institutions of tertiary education is 35.66%, while the subject share for secondary education is considerably lower, about 8.5%. In primary education the share of private schools is negligible (about 1%). Almost two thirds of preschool institutions are private (about 62.5%); however, 13% children attend preschool education programme there.



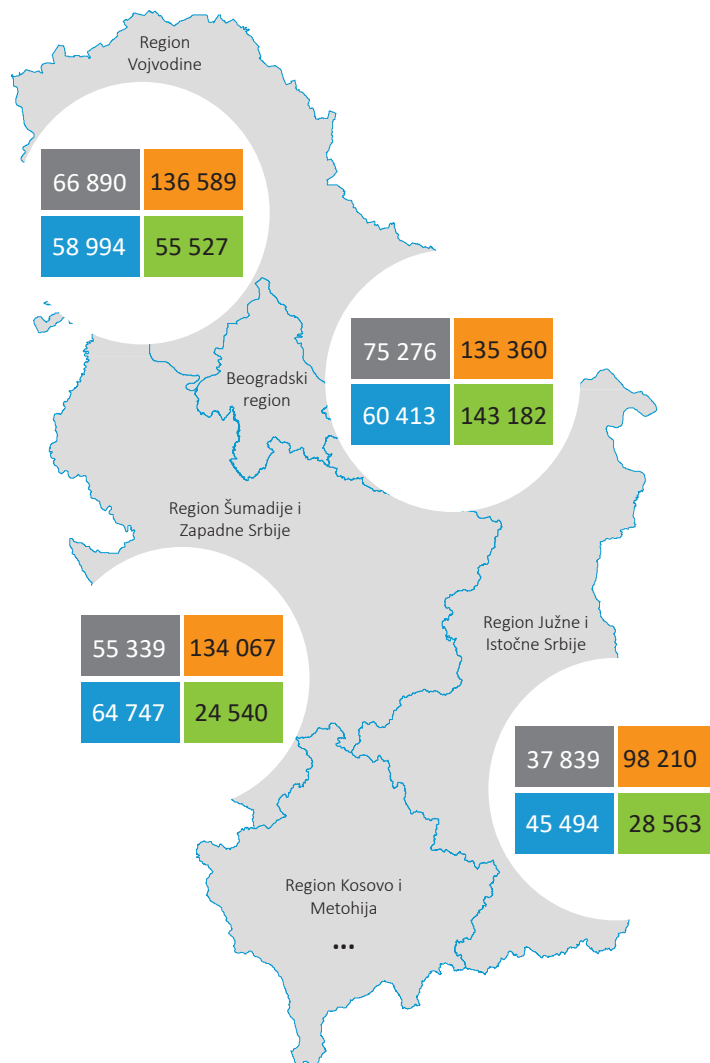

SCIENCE, 2024



In the total number of organizations that are engaged in research and development activities (R&D), in 2024 nonfinancial sector participated with 62.3%, the general government sector with 12.3%, tertiary education with 22.0%, and nonprofit sector with 0.8%. The number of researchers employed with the R&D in 2024 is 19 323.

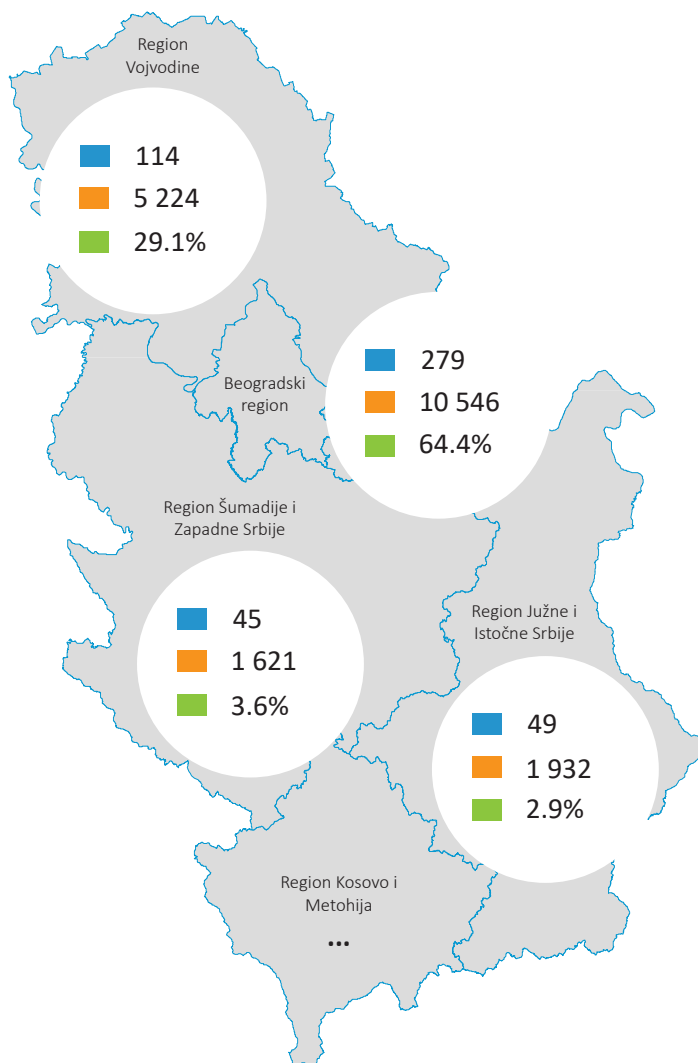
The number of research works (projects and studies) increased in 2024 by 4.5% when related to 2023., where fundamental works participate with 54.1%, applied works with 28.2%, and development studies with 17.7%. In all expenditures for R&D in 2024, the share of gross fixed capital formation equals 7.9%, and current expenditures 92.1%. In 2024 nonfinancial sector invested in R&D 55.5% of own assets, while the assets of the general and local government were invested in R&D as follows: general government 71.3% and tertiary education 61.8%.

In innovations that were introduced, the largest share expressed production process innovations, 41.3%. The share of income from the products/services innovations that were new in the market equals 9.0%, and those that were new for the economic subject equals 10.7% in relation to the total income of the subject innovator.

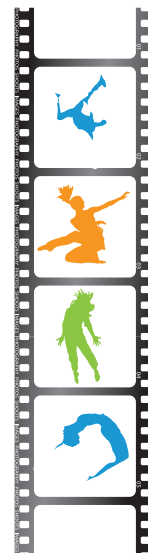
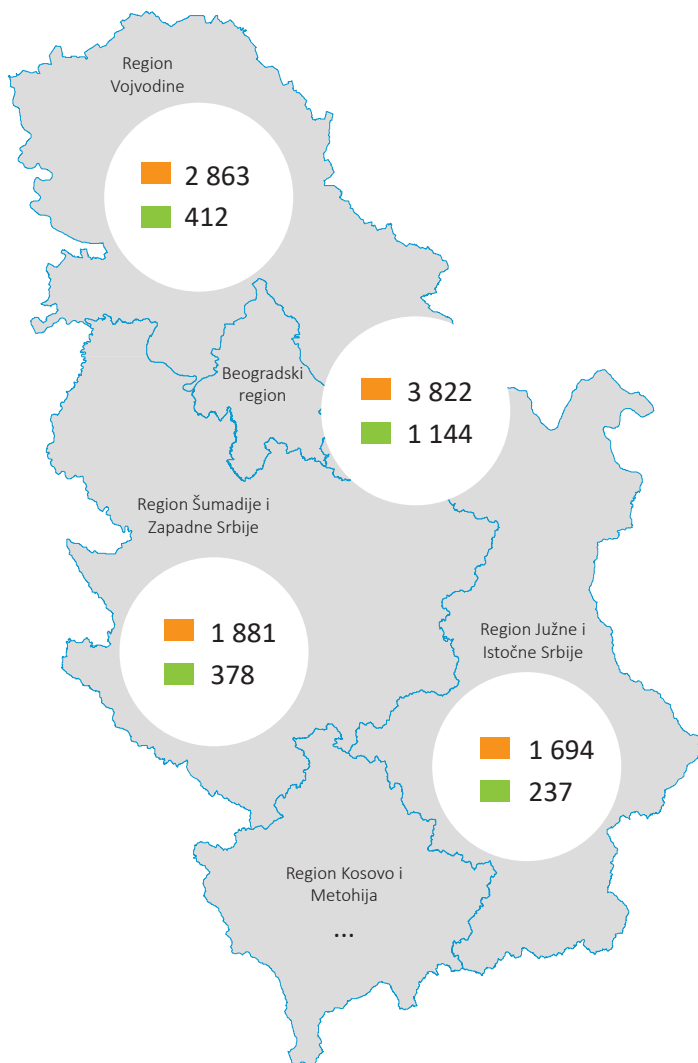
CULTURE, 2024

In 2024 the structural shares of cinema projections were expressive: domestic movies 17.5%, and foreign movies 82.5%. In the total number of theatres in 2023/24 the largest share went for amateur theatres – 48.5%, professional – 38.1%, and children theatres – 13.4%. In the total number of radio stations in 2024 private stations were represented with 80.5%, public stations with 12.7%, and other stations with 6.8%. Similar is the structure of TV stations: private – 78.8%, public – 18.5%, and other – 1.7%. In the total number of libraries in 2024, the share of the national libraries equalled 0.1%, the libraries of tertiary education – 5.5%, school libraries 61.4%, special libraries – 7.5%, and public libraries – 25.5%. In the total book fund, the share of the national libraries equalled 12.9%, the libraries of tertiary education – 9.3%, school libraries 31.6%, special libraries – 5.5%, and public libraries – 40.7%. The structure of the serial publications in 2023 is the following: 11.7% newspapers/papers, 84.2% magazines and 4.1% other serials.

LABOUR MARKET, 2024



In 2024, in the Republic of Serbia the average gross salaries and wages amounted to RSD 135 403, while the average taxes and contributions deducted salaries and wages (net) amounted to RSD 98 143. When related to 2023, the average gross salaries and wages increased by 14.2% in nominal terms, and increased by 9.2% in reals terms, while the average net salaries and wages increased by 14.1% in nominal terms, and by 9.1% in reals terms. Observed on the level of regions, the highest net average salaries and wages were acquired in Beogradski region and amounted to RSD 124 010, which is by 13.3% more in nominal terms when related to 2023. The lowest average net salaries and wages amounting to RSD 82 433 were acquired in Region Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije, which is by 15.1% more in nominal terms when compared to the average value of the previous year.

The total number of registered employment in 2024 amounted to 2 368 948 persons, which means it increased in relation to the previous year by 0.4%. Observed by regions, the highest percentage growth was noted for Beogradskom region (0.9%), while the most expressive fall was recorded in Region Južne i Istočne Srbije (0.7%).

In accordance with the Labour Force Survey in 2024 the rate employment equalled 51.4% on the level of Republic of Serbia, which is a growth by 1.2 p. p. when related to the year 2023. The highest rate of employment was recorded for Beogradski region (55.9%), and the lowest for Region Južne i Istočne Srbije (40.7%). In Regionu Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije this rate recorded the value of 50.7%, and in Region Vojvodine 51.3%. The rate of unemployment in 2024 equalled 8.6%, which is by 0.8 p. p. less than in the year 2023. Observed on the level of regions, the unemployment rate recorded the lowest value in Beogradskom regionu (6.2%), while regarding Region Vojvodine and Regionu Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije this indicator equalled 8.4% and 8.5%, respectively. Region Južne i Istočne Srbije recorded the highest rate of unemployment equalling 12.1%. In 2024 the rate of population out of labour force is by 0.8 p. p. lower than in the previous year, namely it equalled 43.8%. Region Južne i Istočne Srbije noted the highest rate of population out of labour force (46.5%), while the lowest value for this indicator was recorded in Beogradski region (40.4%).

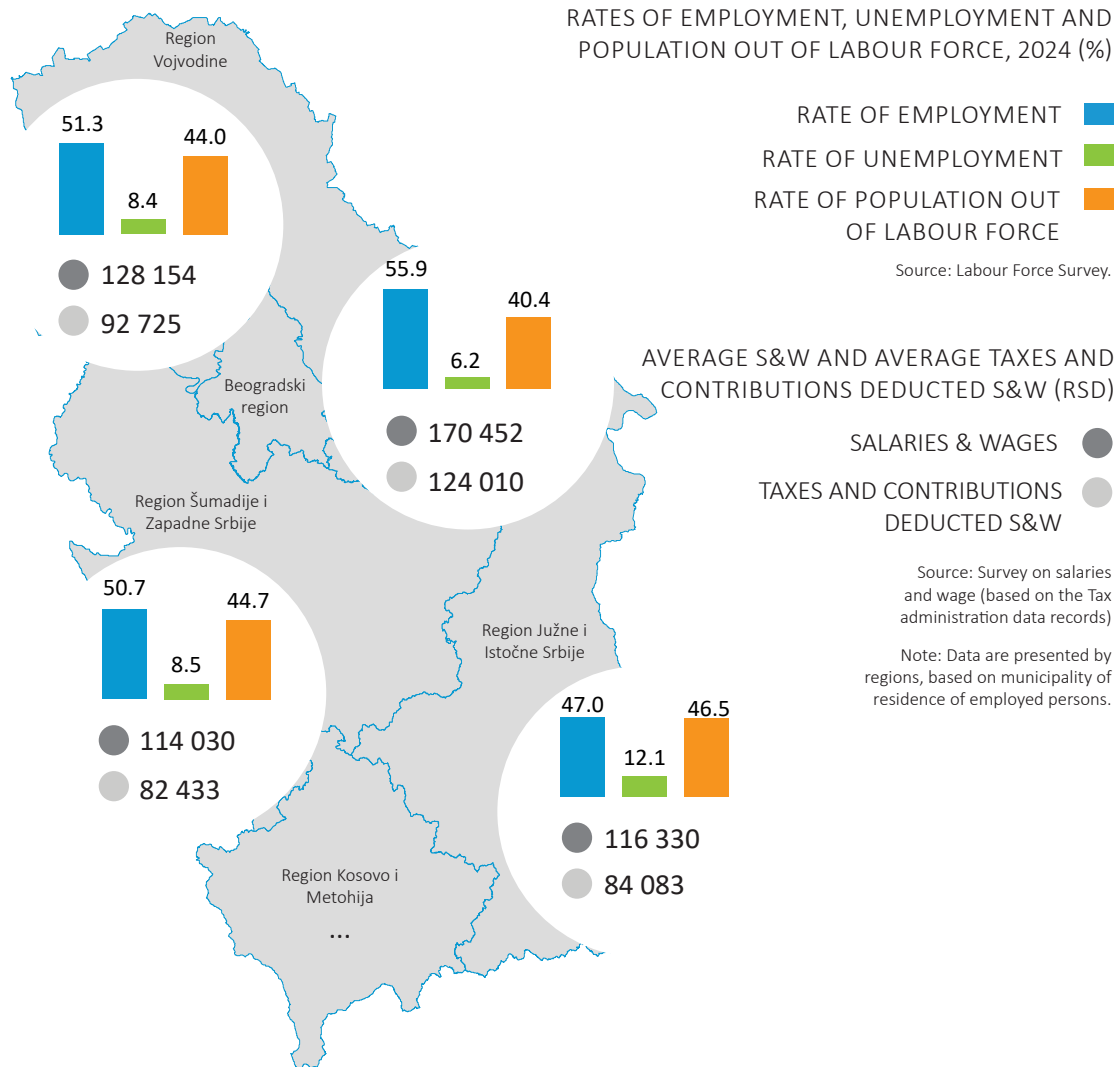

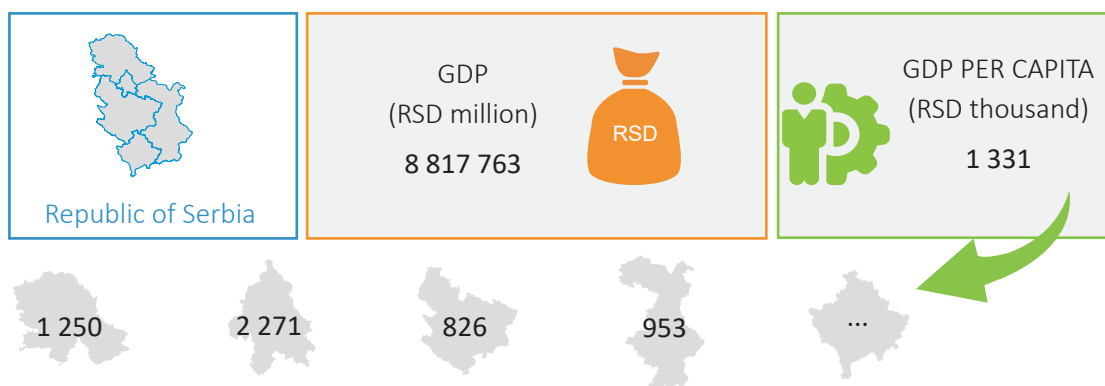

GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT, 2023 - NON-REVISED DATA¹ -

In accordance with the (calculation) principle of the place of work, the share of certain regions in the Serbian Gross domestic product is following: Beogradski region holds the leading position with 43.3%; then comes Region Vojvodine with 24.6%, further followed by Region Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije with 17.0%, and Region Južne i Istočne Srbije with 15.1%.

Beogradski region, with the GDP per capita amount of RSD 2 271 000.00 has by 70.6% higher GDP per capita amount in relation to the RS level. The GDP per capita level index for Region Vojvodine equals 93.9 % (RSD 1 250 000.00), which indicates a fall of 3.1% when related to the year 2022. For Region Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije the level index is 62.1% (RSD 826 000.00), which presents a fall of 4.1% when related to 2022. For Region Južne i Istočne Srbije the level index equals 71.6% (RSD 953 000.00), which is less by 2.2% when related to 2022.



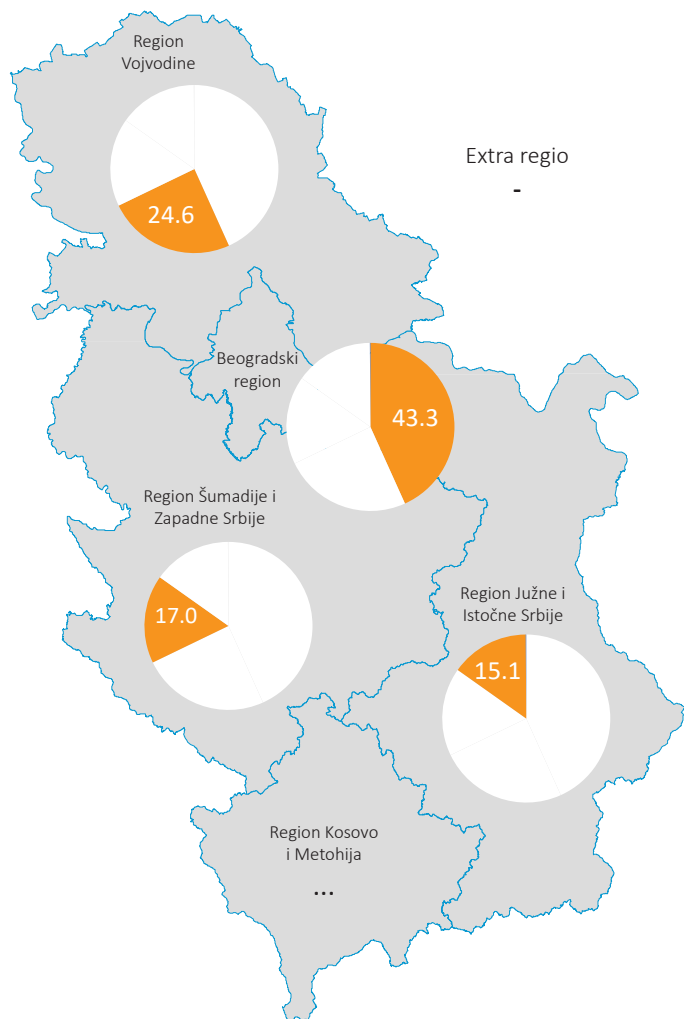

CONSUMPTION, INCOME AND LIVING CONDITIONS, 2024

In 2024 the average monthly income in money and in kind per household amounted to RSD 97 705, and individual consumption household expenditure amounted to RSD 98 165. When related to 2023, the average monthly income in money and in kind increased by 11.1%, and individual consumption household expenditure increased by 11.2% in nominal terms.

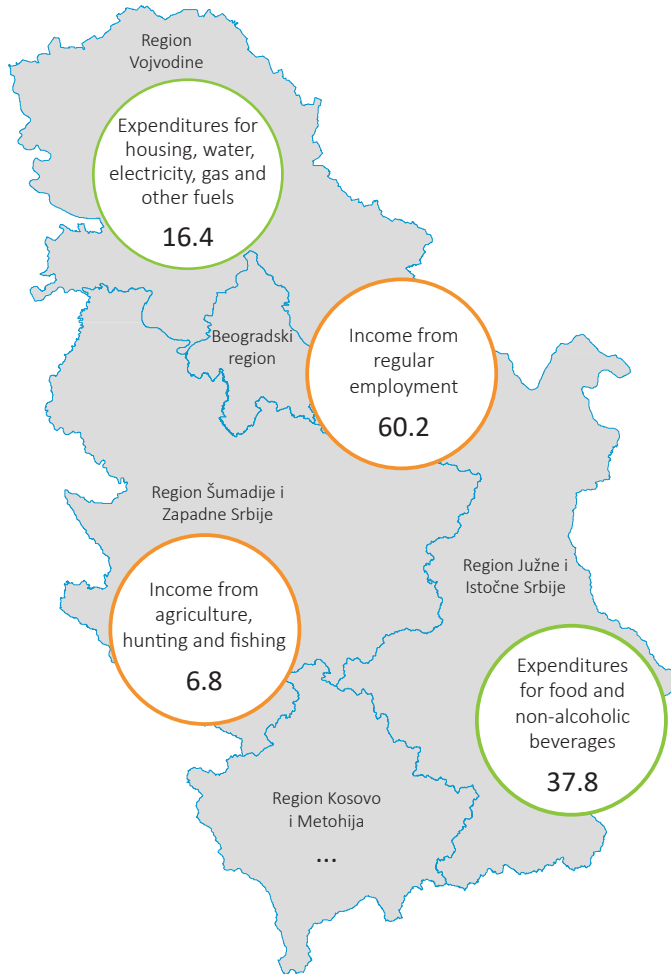
The largest share in income in money and in kind had the income from regular employment – 53.4%, pensions – 30.6%, income from agriculture, hunting and fishing – 3.9%, natural consumption – 2.6%, income from out of regular employment – 2.3%, social insurance-based receipts – 2.3%, and 4.9% went to receipts from other sources.

The largest share in individual consumption of households made the expenditures for food and non-alcoholic beverages – 36.6% and for housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels – 16.3%. Then followed expenditures for transport – 8.9%, for other individual items and other services – 5.9%, for communication – 5.4%, for recreation and culture – 5.2%, for clothing and footwear – 4.7%, for alcoholic beverages and tobacco – 4.4%, for health – 4.1%, and 8.5% made the expenditures for other groups of individual consumption.

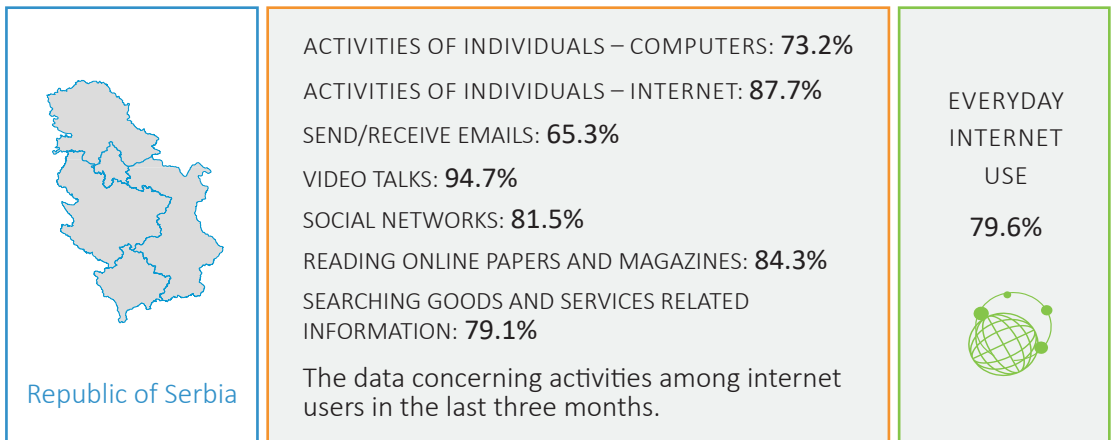

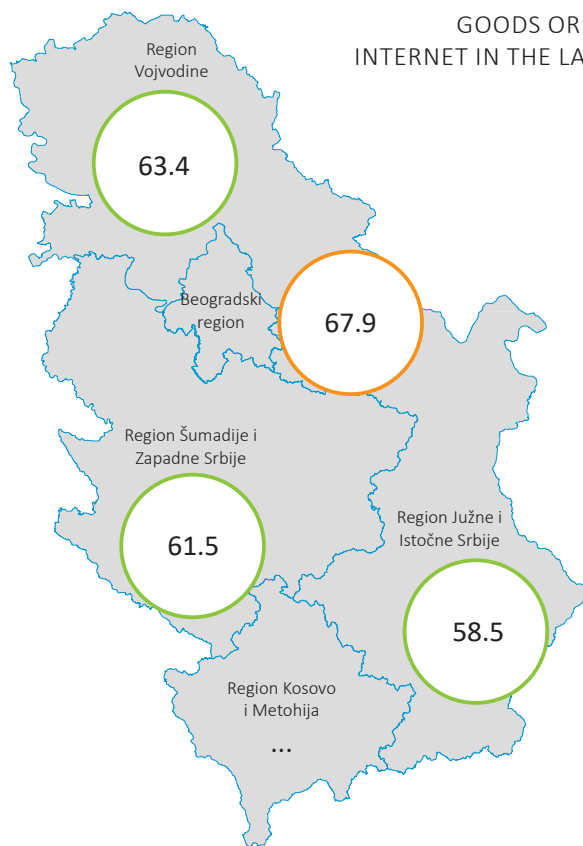
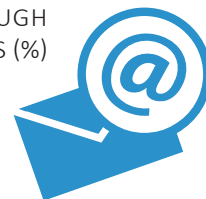
In the Republic of Serbia, in 2024 the share of households possessing computer equals 73.4%, which is by 2.5 p. p. less than in 2023. The representativeness of computers is largest in Beogradski region and equals 84.3%, in Region Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije it equals 68.5%. In Region Vojvodine the share of households with computer equals 70.4%, while for Region Južne i Istočne Srbije the representativeness of computers equals 67.7%.

CONSTRUCTION, 2024

The value of completed works in the territory of the Republic of Serbia in 2024 amounted to USD 795 597 million. Observed by regions, in 2024 the share in the works done was highest in Beogradski region (31.2%), Region Vojvodine (28.5%), then following are Region Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije (24.8%), and Region Južne i Istočne Srbije (15.5%).

In 2024, by type of constructions, the value of works completed on buildings equalled 42.7%, and 57.2% equalled the value of other civil engineering works (transport infrastructure; pipelines, communication and electric lines; complex industrial structures; and other constructions, n.m.e). If only buildings are regarded, 39.2% of the completed works value concerns residential buildings, and 60.8% concerns non-residential buildings; as regards other constructions, the major part concerns transport infrastructure – 65.4% of the total value of other civil engineering works.

In 2024, the number of 35 380 dwellings was completed and the average floor space of them covered 75.9 m².

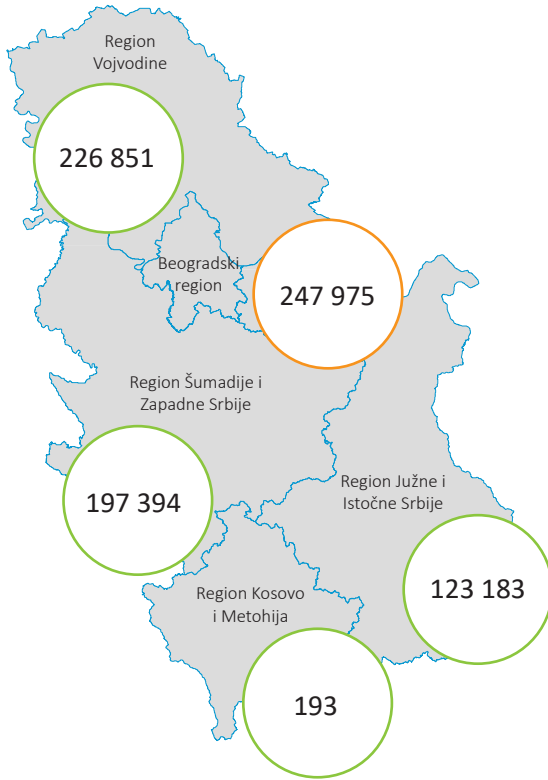

EXTERNAL TRADE, 2024

The exports value amounted to USD 33 038.5 million, which means it increased by 6.8% if related to corresponding period of the previous year, and the value of imports amounted to USD 42 263.4 million, which is more by 6.1% than in the previous year.

The exports value expressed in euros amounted to EUR 30 503.4 million, which means it increased by 6.5% if related to the previous year. The value of imports expressed in euros amounted to EUR 39 044.2 million, which is more by 5.9% than in the previous year.

Deficit amounted to USD 9 224.9 million, i.e. increased by 3.6% when related to the previous year. Expressed in euros, deficit amounted to EUR 8 540.9 million, which is more by 3.8% if compared to the previous year.

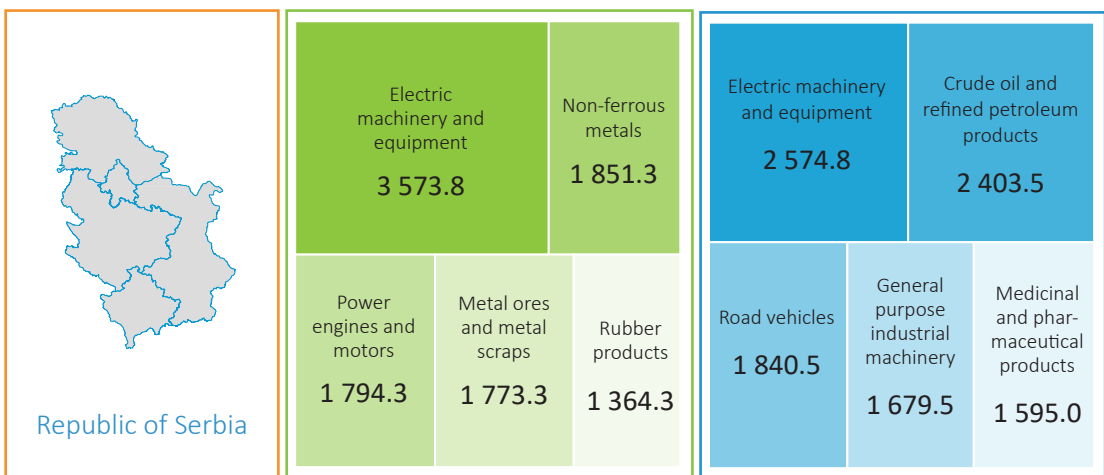
Exports – imports ration equalled 78.2%, and was higher than that in the previous year when it equalled 77.7%.

Exports and imports by regions were presented according to the head office location of the goods' proprietor in the moment of the acceptance of the customs document. This fact needs to be considered when interpreting the data by regions. For example, the data on imports of crude oil and gas are mostly collected in Region Vojvodine and Beogradski region; however, these are energy commodities concerning the whole territory of Serbia.

External trade in goods expressed the highest value with the countries that the Republic of Serbia has concluded free trade agreements. The EU Member States accounted for 58.8% of the total trade volume.

The second by importance partner of Serbia are CEFTA countries that accounted for 8.9% of the total external trade in goods with Serbia, and with these countries constat suffices are expressive.

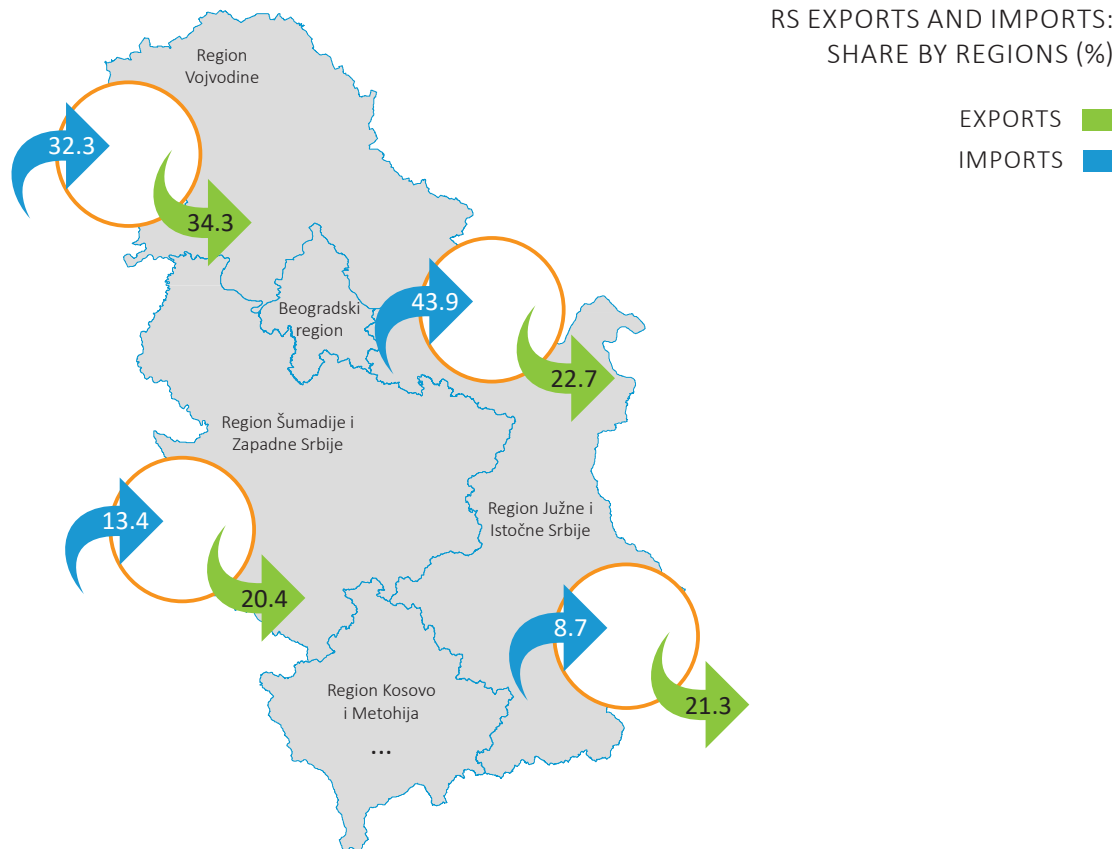
According to the Standard Trade Classification (SITC), exports of the first five sections made 34.0% of all exports. The imports value of the first five section equalled 25.9% of all imports. For the section "unclassified goods", where presently also goods from the customs warehouse and in the free zone are included, the share in the total imports equalled 12.6%.

RS EXPORTS AND IMPORTS: SHARE BY REGIONS (%)

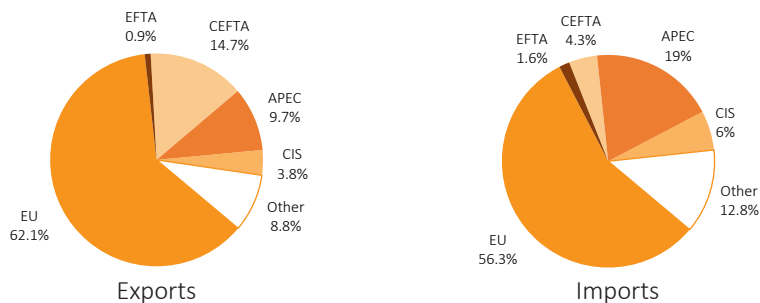

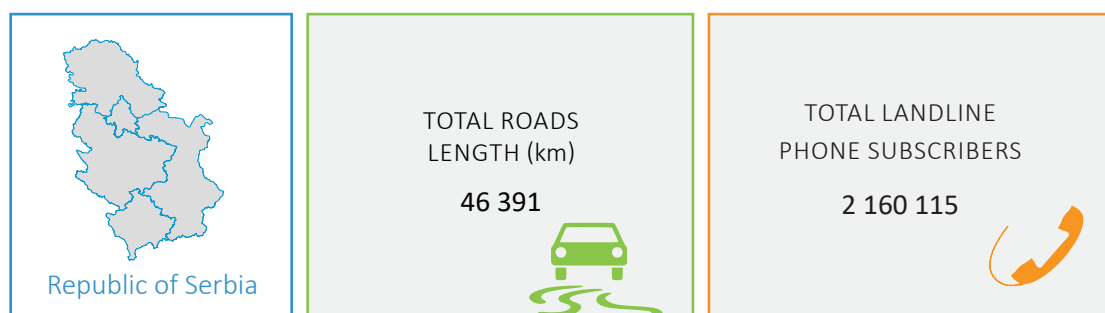
TRANSPORTATION AND TELECOMMUNICATION, 2024

The number of registered mopeds in the Republic of Serbia amounts to 38 129, motorcycles 65 909, passenger cars 2 476 419, buses 11 659, and freight vehicles 307 815.

The economic subjects registered for the activity of passengers and goods transport by road in total transported 52 663 thousand passengers by using 3 098 busses, in addition to 22 502 thousand tonnes of goods by using 11 254 freight vehicles.

Within the public utility city transport service of the Republic of Serbia transported were in total 1 015 789 thousand passengers (including the passengers of BG-voza/BG train), by using 3 749 transport vehicles.

In the territory of the Republic of Serbia 1 656 units of post network, by the means of which transported were 204 310 thousand letter mails and 2 582 thousand parcel mails. The total number of landline phone subscribers in the Republic of Serbia amounts to 2 160 115.

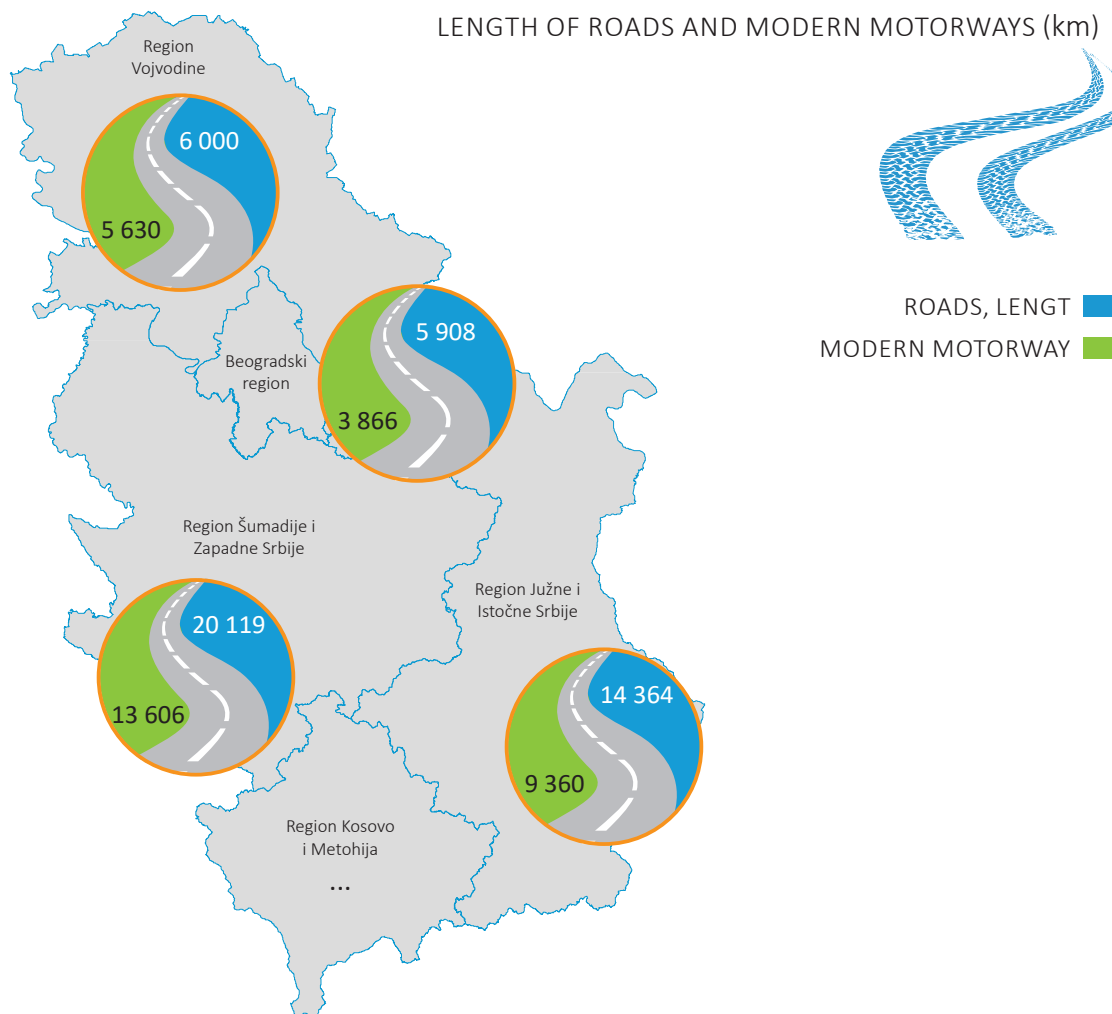

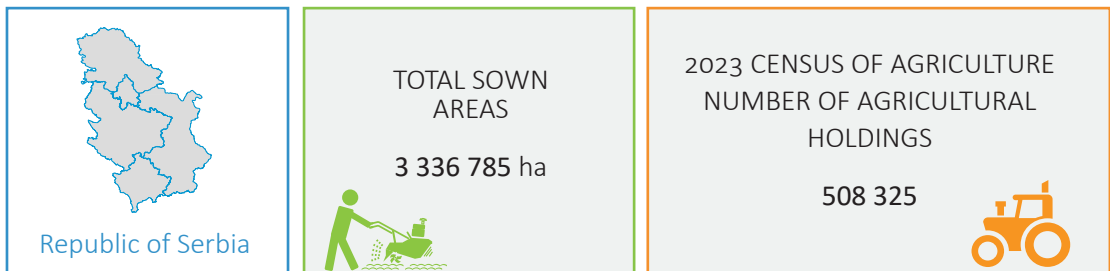
AGRICULTURE, 2024

In the Republic of Serbia, with the state as of 1 December 2024 related to 1 December 2023, registered was the total number of cattle decreased by 3.7%, while the total number of pigs increased by 9.7%, sheep increased by 2.5%, and poultry increased by 3.5%.

Cattle is mostly raised in Region Šumadije i Zapadne Srbije (45.6% in relation to the total number of cattle in the territory of the Republic of Serbia), and pigs are mostly raised in Region Vojvodine (43.7%).

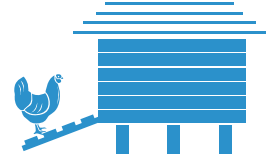
In the Republic of Serbia in 2024 related to 2023, registered were decreased quantities of sown cultures: wheat (by 19.5%), barley (by 9.8%), oats (by 15.9%), and increased quantities of sugar beet (by 12.4%), maize (by 7.0%), sunflower (by 3.4%) and soya (by 3.8%).

When compared to the ten-year average (2014 – 2023), decreased sown quantities are notable for wheat (by 9.4%), and increased quantities for soya (by 5.9%), sunflower (by 15.9%), maize (by 0.4%) and sugar beet (by 3.3%).

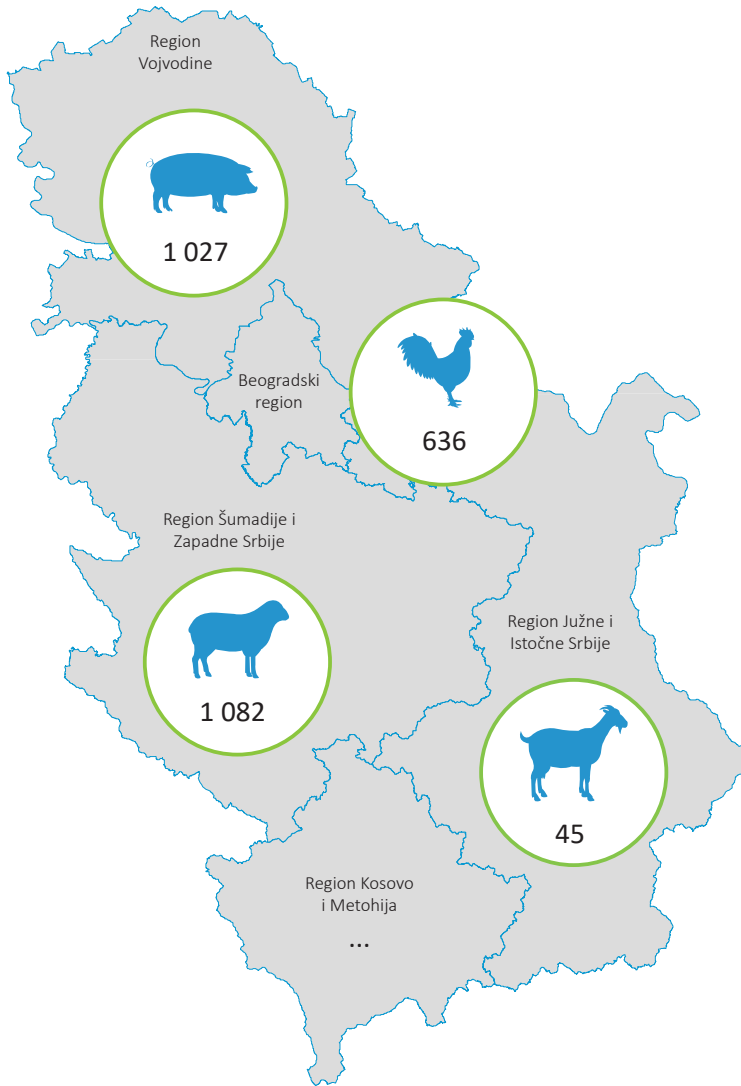

TOURISM AND CATERING TRADE, 2024

The total number of tourists active in 2024 amounted to 4 433 thousand. Of this number domestic tourists accounted for 2 048 thousand, which is less by 0.5% than in 2023, while the number of

2 385 foreign tourists visited our country and this was more by 11.7% when compared to 2023.

The number of overnight stays that made all tourists that used accommodation facilities amounted to 12 662 thousand and equalled by 1.8% more when related to the previous year (2023). Domestic tourists made 6 564 thousand overnight stays, namely less by 4.3% in relation to 2023, while the number of overnight stays made by foreign tourists was by 9.2% larger than in 2023 and amounted to 6 098 thousand.

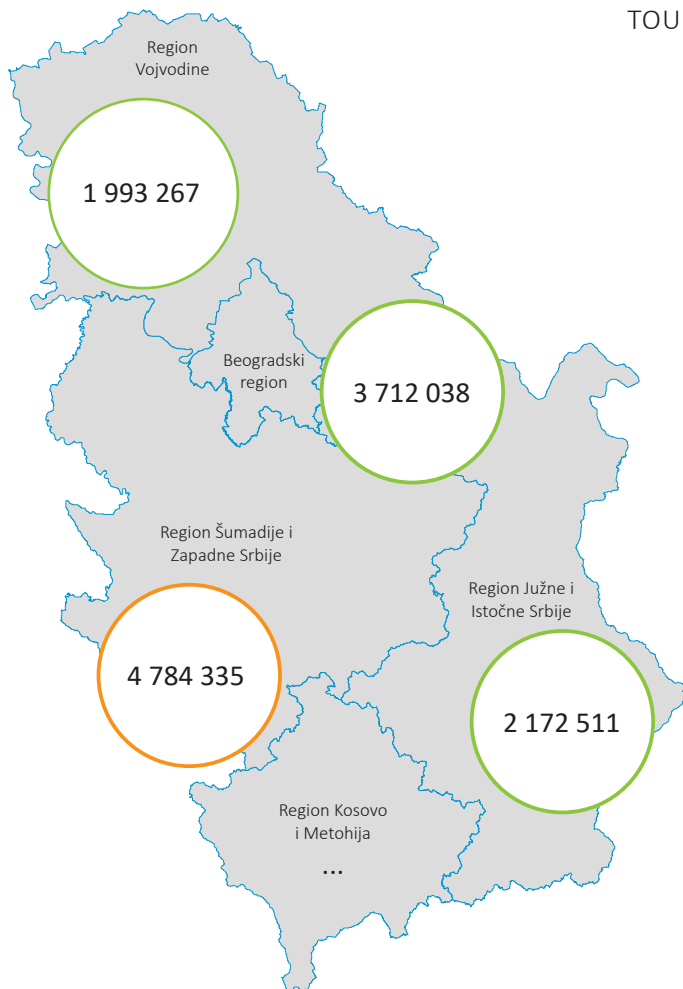
The number of 2 555 thousand tourist overnight stays was made in spas, of that 82.6% by domestic tourists (2 110 thousand). In mountain resorts registered were 2 906 thousand overnight stays, of which number 77.6% overnight stays made domestic tourists.

Observed by individual tourist places/towns, the largest number of overnight stays was registered in Belgrade (3 194 thousand) and Novi Sad (428 thousand). Regarding mountain resorts, the largest number of foreign tourists' overnight stays went for Zlatibor (341 thousand) and Kopaonik (154 thousand). As for spas, the largest number of foreign tourists' overnight stays was registered for Vrnjačka Banja (110 thousand) and Banja Koviljača (78 thousand).

The largest number of foreign tourists that visited Serbia came from Turkey (233 thousand arrivals, 604 thousand overnight stays), Russian Federation (185 thousand arrivals, 622 overnight stays), Bosnia and Herzegovina (168 thousand arrivals, 375 thousand overnight stays) and from China, including Hong Kong (157 thousand arrivals, 404 overnight stays).

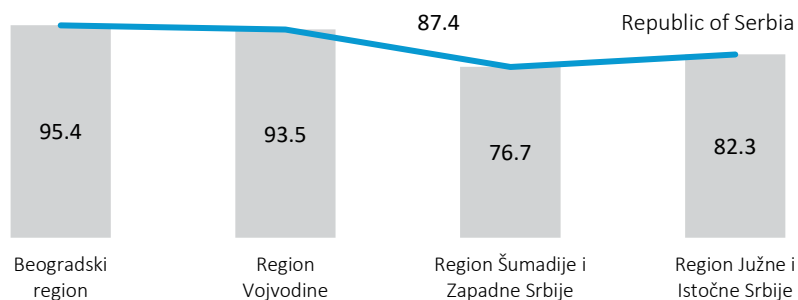

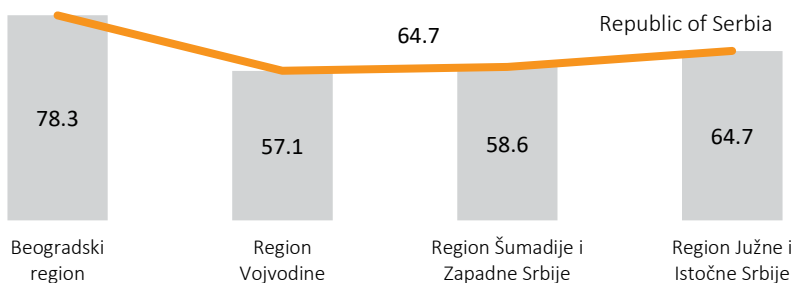

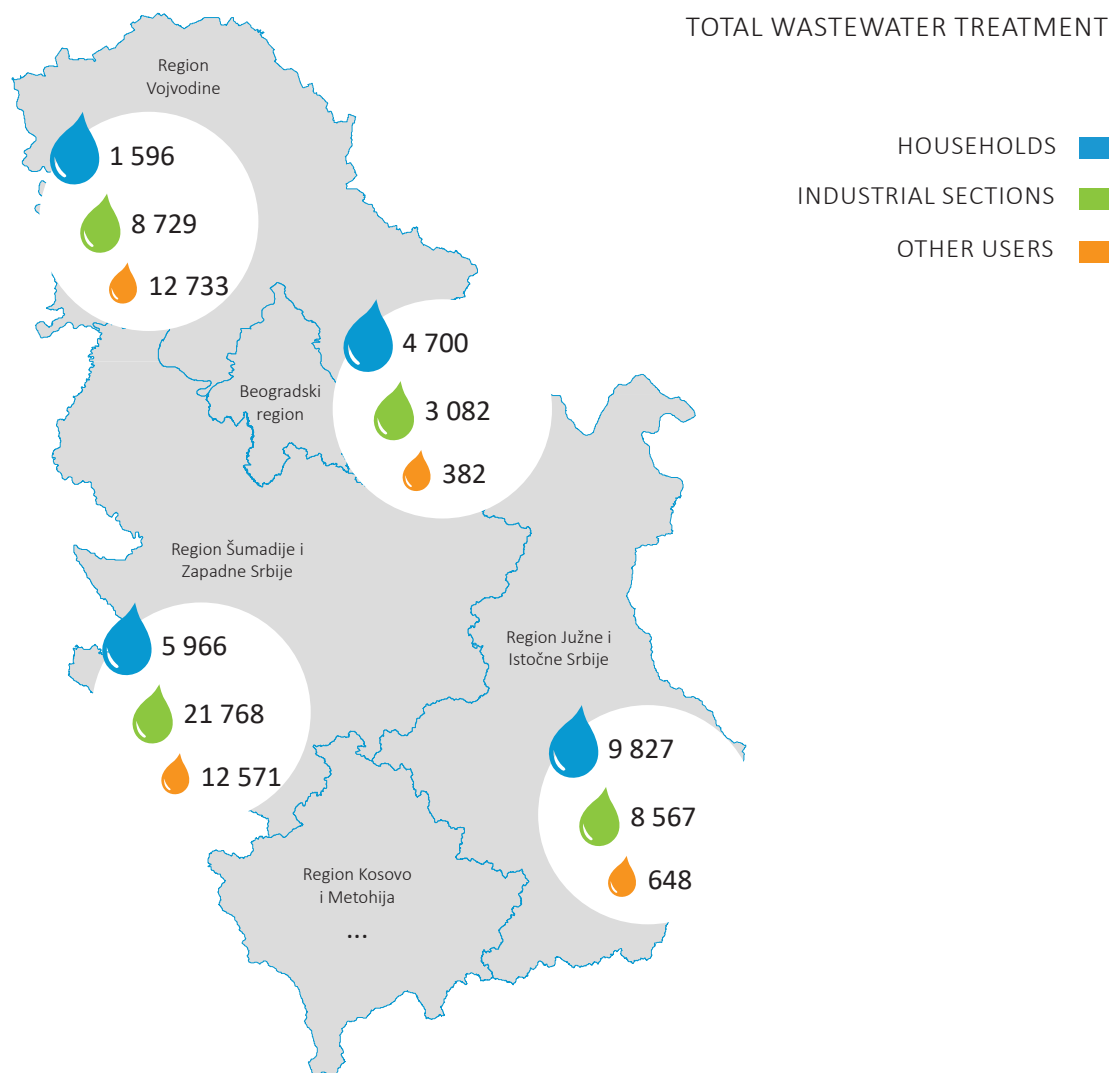
HOUSEHOLDS CONNECTED TO PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM (%)

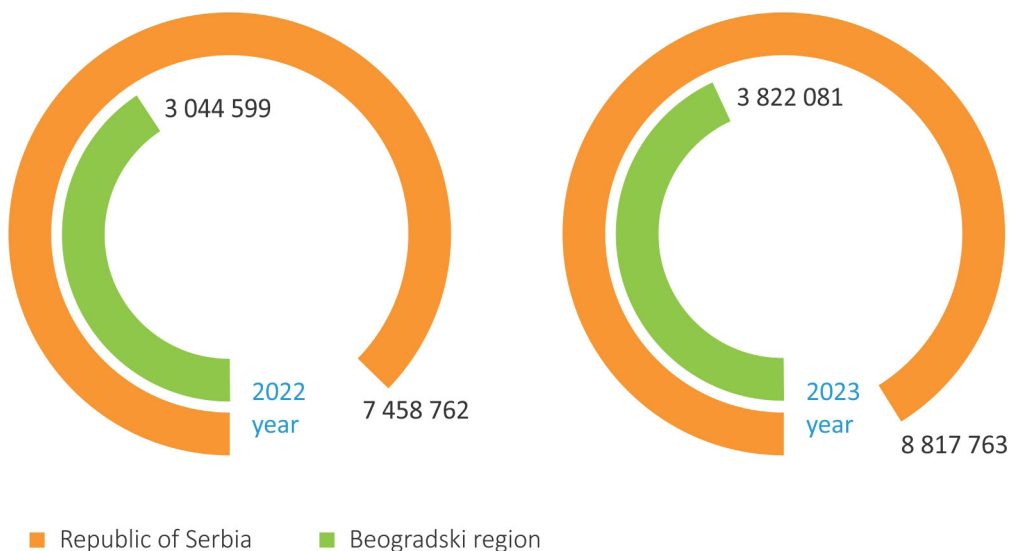

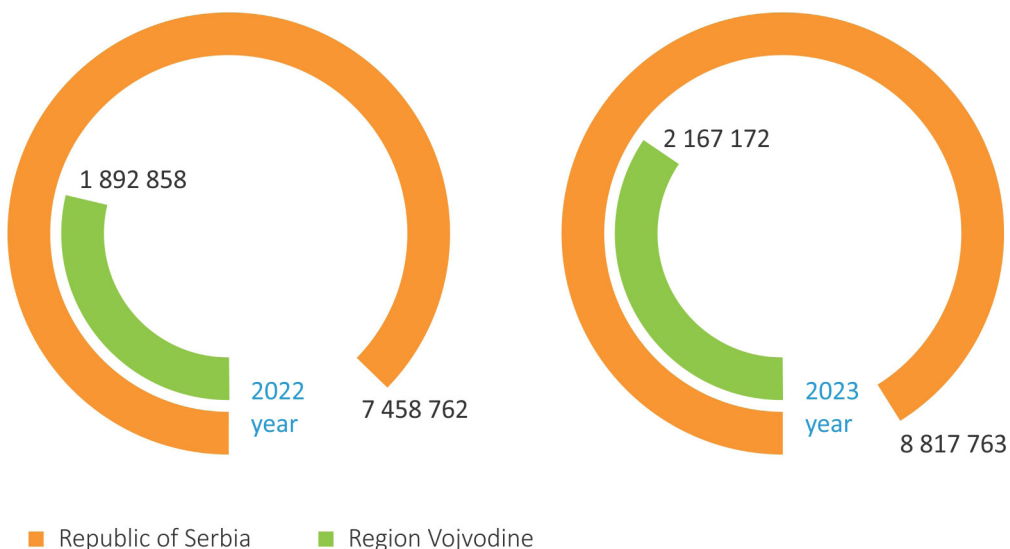

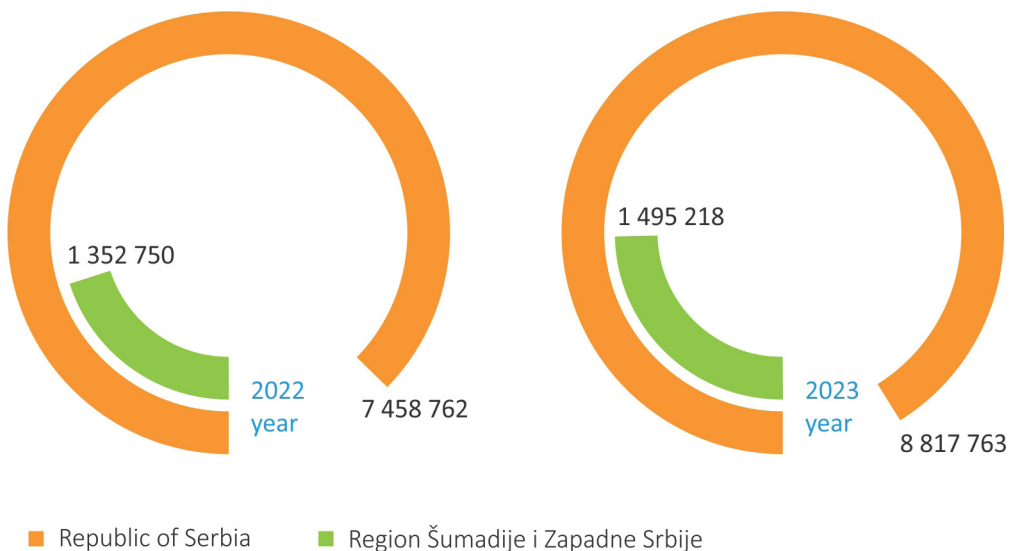

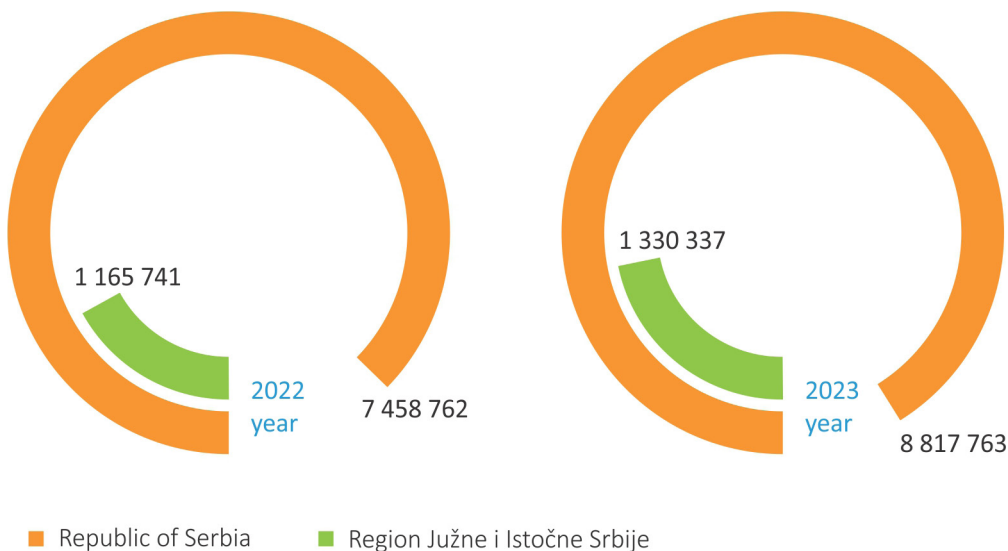
