Total transport of passengers and goods

First half of 2025

Number of transported passengers in the first six months of 2025, relative to the same period 2024, decreased by 7.7%, whereof number of passengers in domestic transport decreased by 8.0% and in international transport, by 4.6%. In air transport, increase of 6.8% was recorded, while in road transport, it decreased by 8.8%. Referring to passengers in railway transport, decrease of 7.3% was noted. Operations volume, expressed in pkm, decreased by 16.3%. Goods transported in the first half of 2025 remained unchanged, relative to the same period 2024. Regarding the same period, expressed in tkm, operations volume increased by 2.0%. Air transport and railway transport recorded decrease in quantity of transported goods, while inland waterway, pipeline and railway transport noted increase.

Road passenger transport decreased relative to the first half of the previous year, with volume operations fall of 14.6%. Referring to the road transport of goods, there was an increase of 0.8%, and operations volume noted decrease of 1.0%, expressed in tkm and relative to the same period 2024.

Air transport expressed increase referring to passengers transport. Number of transported passengers increased by 6.8% and realized passenger kilometres increased by 17.1%. Quantity of transported goods decreased by 17.2% and operations volume, expressed in tkm, noted decrease of 15.0%.

Decreased number of transported passengers in railway transport in the first half of 2025 amounted to 7.3%. Recorded was the decreased number of transported passengers in domestic transport by 7.7%, while in international transport, the increase of 5.2% was noted. In the same period goods transport showed the decrease of 12.5%. Operations volume, expressed in tkm, noted decrease of 11.8% relative to the same period 2024.

Inland waterways transport noted increase regarding transported quantities of goods, by 5.9% and regarding operations volume expressed in tkm, it increased by 37.4%.

The oil transport via pipelines increased by 12.2% regarding the transported oil quantities and it increased by 11.2% regarding the tkm made. The natural gas transport increased by 12.9%.

In the border traffic of entering road passengers' vehicles in the first half of 2025 recorded was increase of number of vehicles with Serbian registration plates by 3.7%, if compared to the same period 2024. Out of the total number of vehicles with foreign registration plates that came into Serbia, the majority referred to those from Germany and Hungary.

Postal services in the first half of 2025 compared to the same period 2024 noted the decrease: letter mails decreased by 10.4%, and parcels noted increase of 22.9%. Payment traffic services decreased by 3.6%.

Fixed telephony noted decrease of 17.2%, and mobile telephony decrease of 5.5%.

Total number of the employed in transport section decreased by 1.6% respective to the same period of the previous year.



Graph.1. Scope of work by transport branches, I-VI 2025 Republic of Serbia


